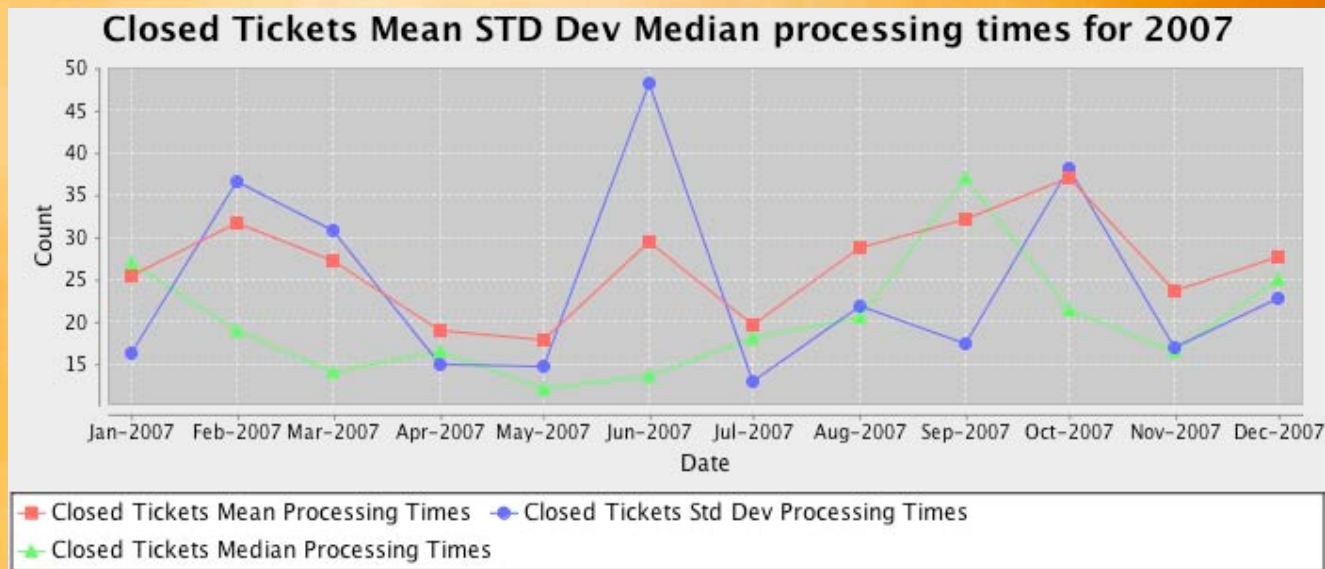
IPv6 for the root servers

- Small increase in load on servers
- No known problems

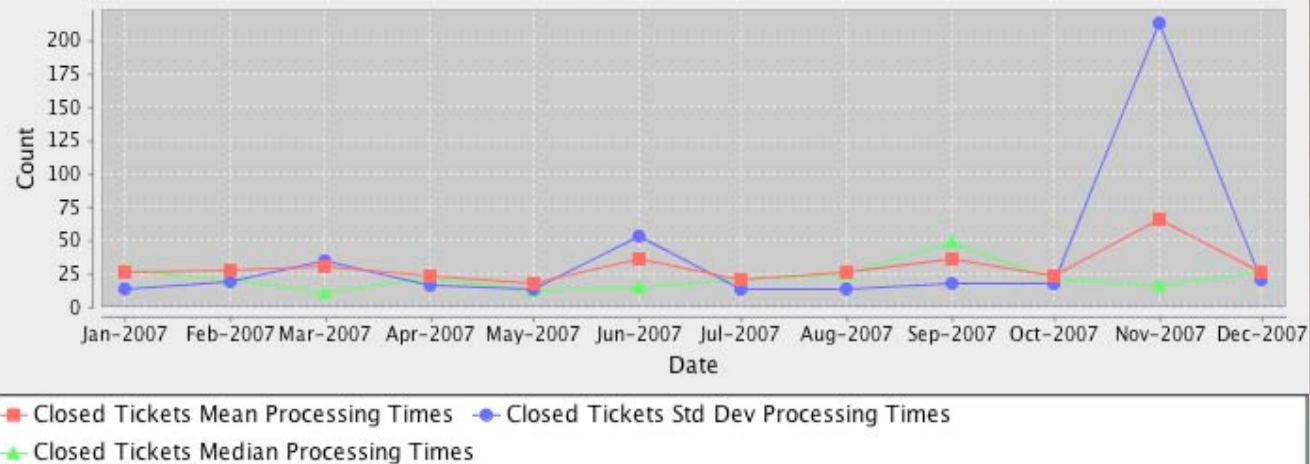

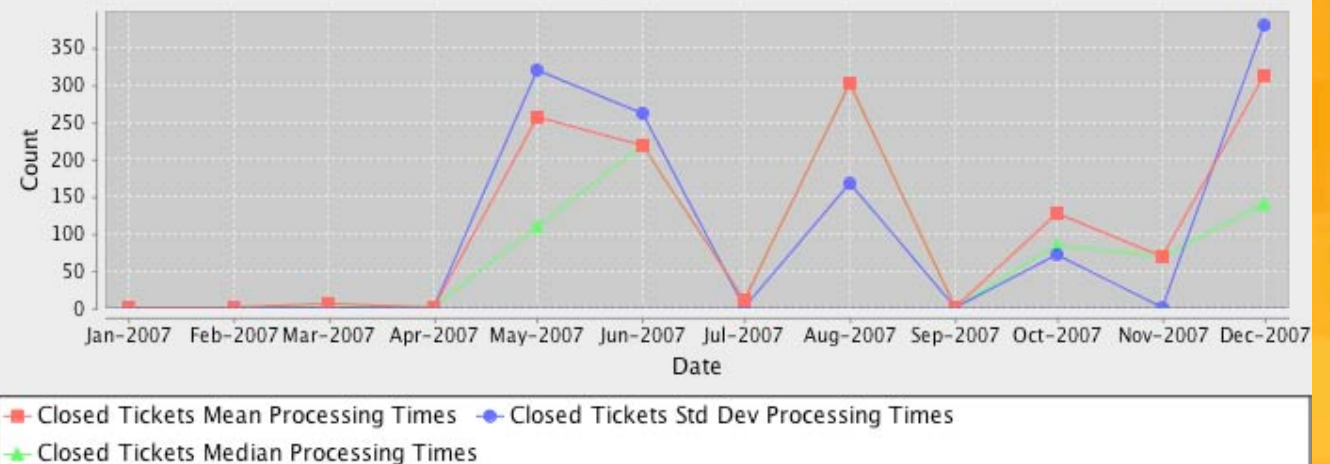


Processing trends

Redelegation/Delegation Tickets Mean STD Dev Median processing times for 2007



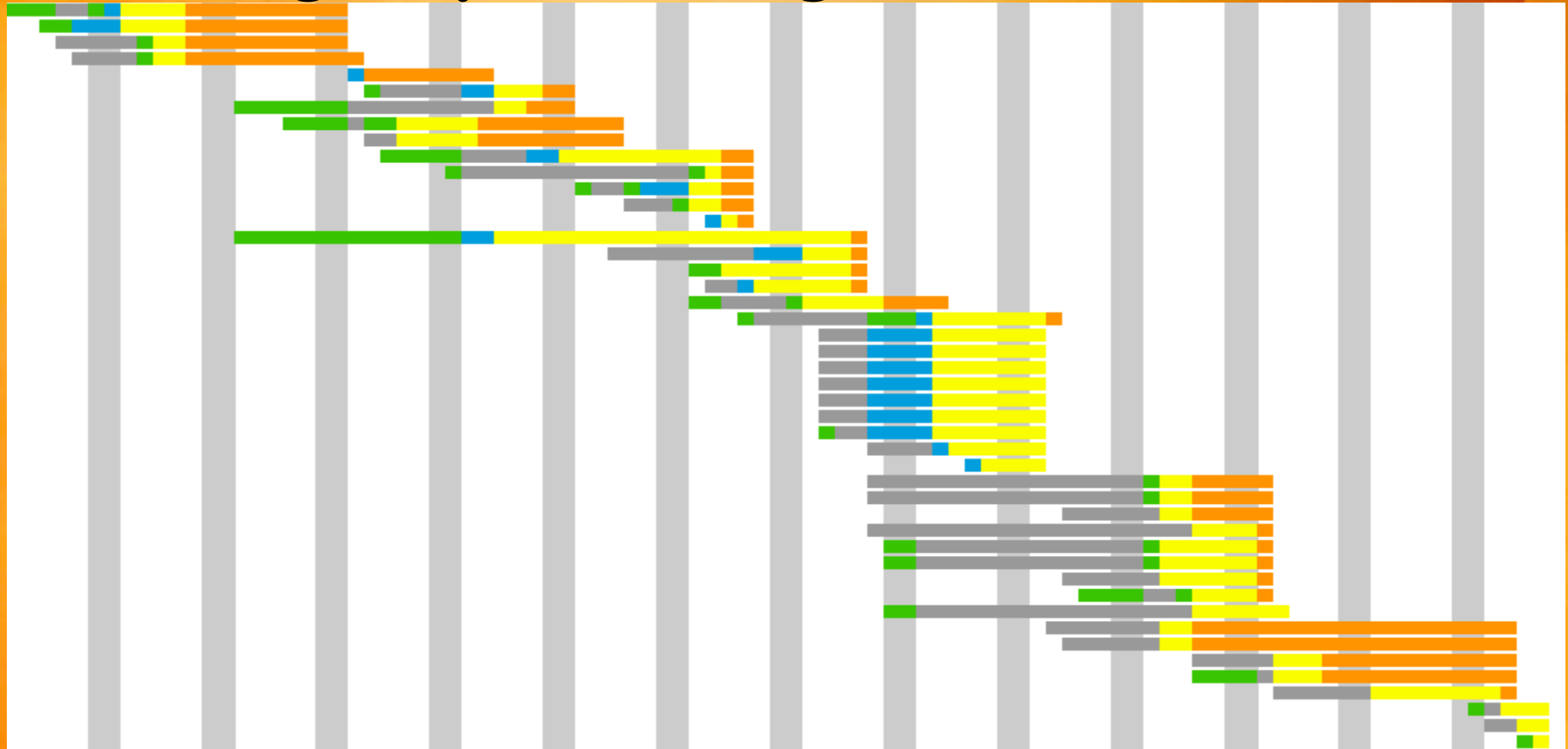

Longer term trends

- Routine requests done faster
- Remaining tickets on average taking longer
 - Redelegations etc. take more due diligence, often more contentious. Building number due to outreach efforts.
- We will study underlying causes and report back
- Propose splitting reporting into “regular” and “irregular”/“exceptional”
 - Need to define the latter — redels and third-party impacting?
