 - Revised Global Outreach recommendations (comment period currently ongoing)
 - Standing Committee to track implementation of the GNSO improvements (charter being drawn up).

- Working Groups and ongoing projects:
 - Competition, consumer trust and choice (Board/GNSO discussions ongoing)
 - Toolkit of services (checklists received from GNSO groups, under staff review)
 - Prioritization (updated workload report sent by staff, discussion with Council ongoing)
 - Issues report on current state of UDRP (overview provided by staff during weekend sessions)
 - Discussion paper on creating best practices to help registrars and registries address abusive DN registrations.
 - Recommendations on WHOIS access and fake renewal notices (discussed with compliance staff during weekend sessions)


Other Actions
