"Conventional" approach: act only on correct legal documents

Position .nl as safe internet environment

Extended access to WHOIS

- Presently, WHOIS shows all data; access non- registrars limited to 15/24hrs
- New WHOIS policy based on Data Protection Laws; limited dataset publicly accessable
- Counter: extended access (quantity and data set) for law enforcement based on contract; use restricted, what we could legally be forced to provide

- Code of Conduct: public private sector collaboration
- Complaint will be processed (passed on or evaluated)
- Clearly unlawful or criminal (rejection or action)
- ISP or eventually registry will act if content owner/provider does not
