



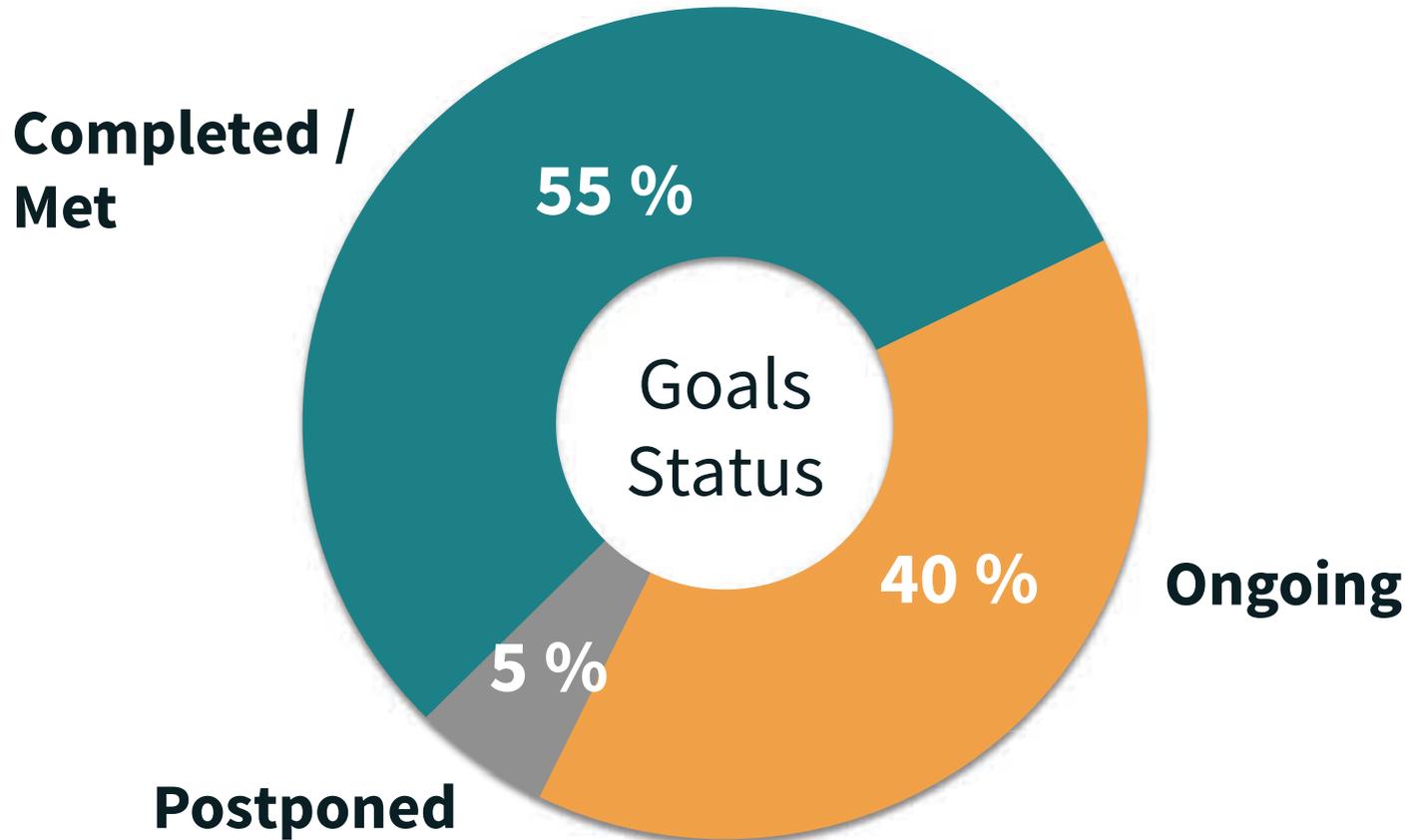

# Technical and Security, Stability & Resiliency

## Key Accomplishments since ICANN 52

- ◉ Delivered 29 identifier security / operations trainings across all of ICANN's regions. Launched a "train the trainer" course on DNS operations with partner Network Startup Resource Center
- ◉ Public consultation on draft plan for rolling the Root Zone DNSSEC Key Signing Key to be initiated immediately after ICANN 53

- ⦿ Executed plan to upgrade cryptographic hardware for signing root zone

First Global Consumer Study on Domain Name System published. Public comment on draft Rights Protection Mechanisms review completed.



## Survey

Initiated a Registry Engagement Survey to measure performance.



## Registrar Accreditation



Public comment completed on revising Accreditation Agreement to aid underserved regions.

## WHOIS (RDDS) Advisory

Finalized with community. Clarifies provisions in registry and registrar agreements.

## Universal Acceptance

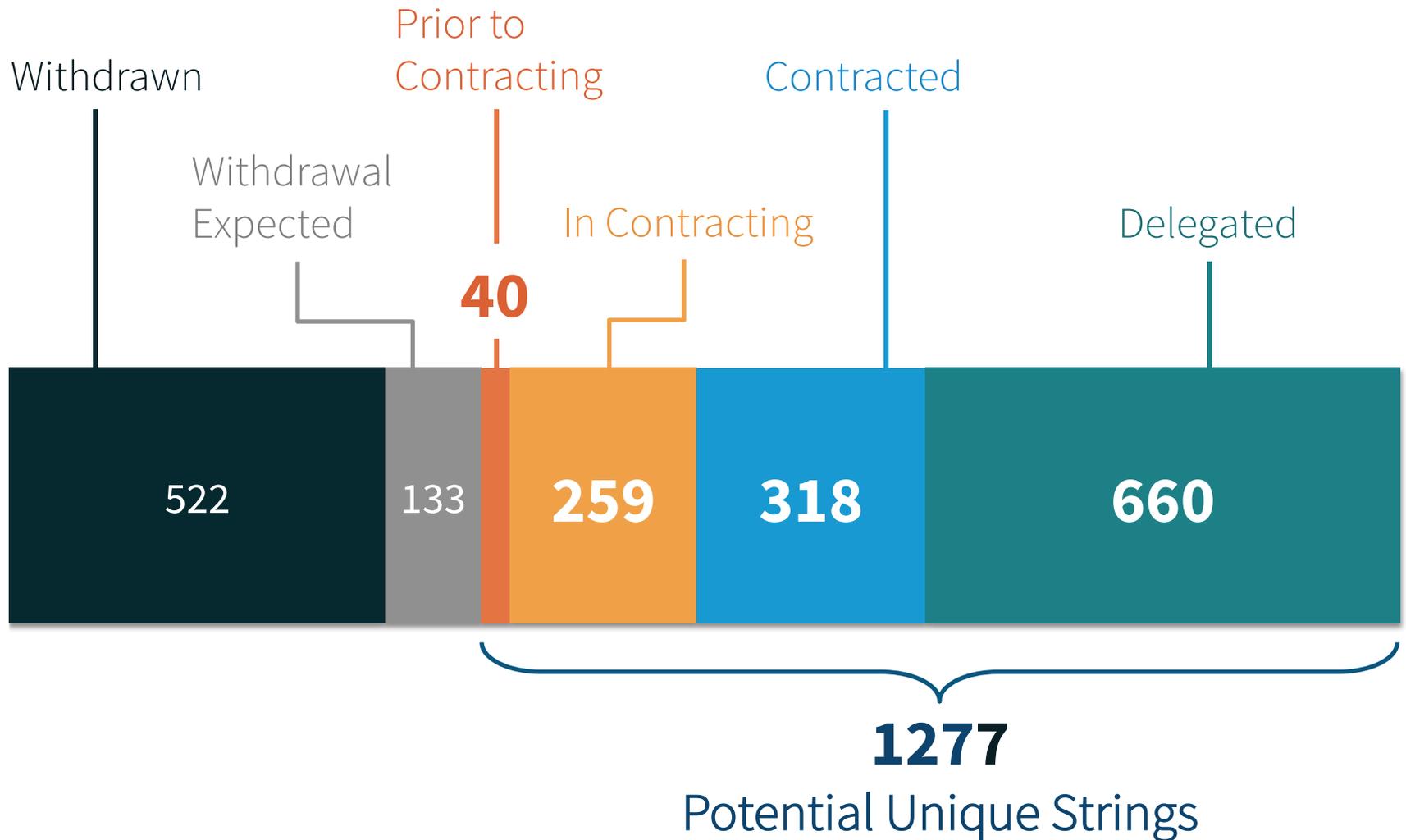
- Steering Group (UASG) leadership seated and charter established.

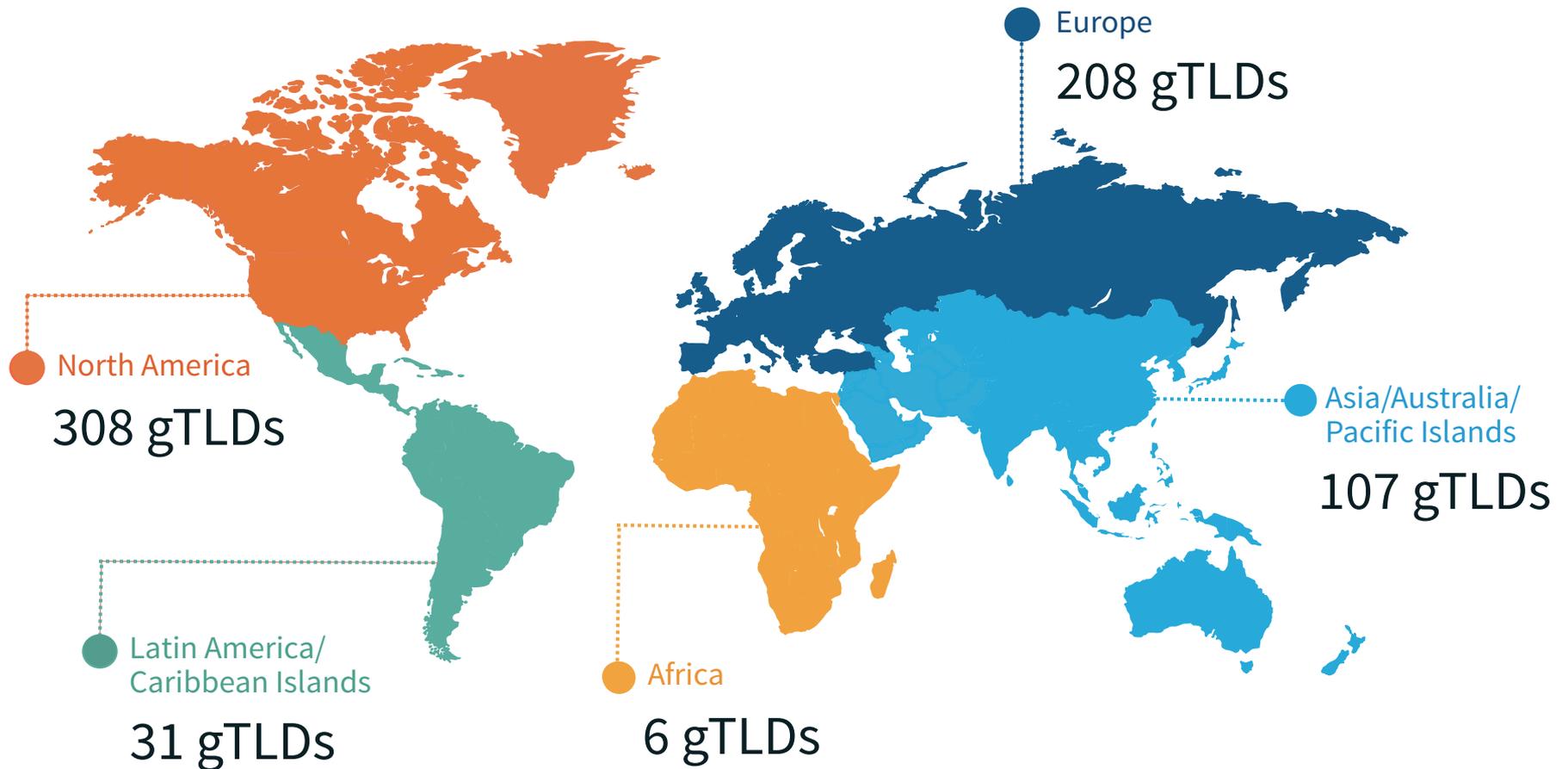
## Internationalized Domain Names

- Arabic and Armenian script communities completed proposals for Label Generation Rules. Currently available for public comment.
- Six scripts added in recent update of Maximal Starting Repertoire  
(Armenian, Ethiopic, Khmer, Myanmar, Thaana, Tibetan)

# New gTLD Program Auction Proceeds

## Contention Resolution Statistics

- ⦿ 88% complete – 204 of 233 contention sets resolved
- ⦿ 40 sets resolved since ICANN 52
- ⦿ 29 sets remain to be resolved
- ⦿ 13 sets resolved via ICANN Auction; 3 resolved since ICANN 52

## Net proceeds to date: US\$ 58.8M

- ⦿ Funds segregated. Community discussing use in Buenos Aires.

## Why Auctions?

Only one registry can operate a top-level domain. Auction is the “mechanism of last resort” for resolving contention for the same string.
