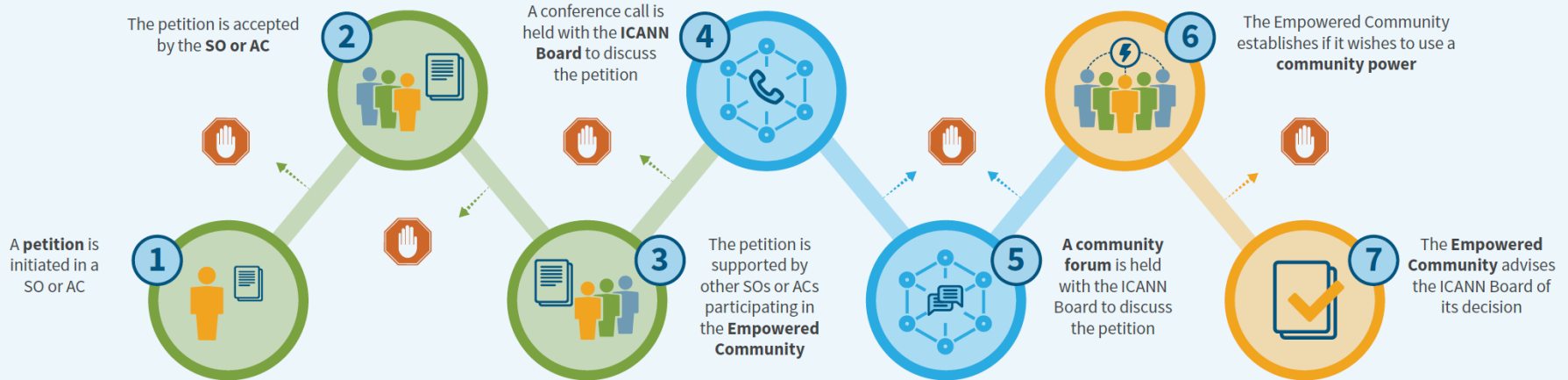

Seven Core Steps in the Escalation Process



Escalation of a concern can be stopped at any point if a threshold is not met or if a solution is found.

- Rejection Action Petition
Manager/Rejection Action Petition
Committee
- Who can submit a petition?
- Requirements for submission
- Process for review of submitted petitions
- Communication with the ccTLD community,
ECA and other DPs
- Defined timelines
- Final decisions
