Background

- Final Recommendations approved by GNSO Council, adopted by Board of Directors in 2016
- Implementation Review Team convened October 2016
- Accreditation Program materials discussed to date:
 - Privacy and Proxy Service Provider Accreditation Agreement (PPAA) [Draft]
 - Privacy and Proxy Service Provider Accreditation Policy [Draft]
 - Privacy and Proxy Service Provider Applicant Guide [Draft]
 - Privacy and Proxy Service Provider De-Accreditation Process [Draft]
 - Privacy and Proxy Service Provider Accreditation Program Fees Proposal

Background

- Project status:
 - IRT has provided feedback on all draft accreditation program materials
 - IRT has discussed potential approaches to address data privacy issues in accreditation program requirements
 - ICANN org has considered IRT feedback on draft accreditation program materials

Data Privacy Issues

- Significant uncertainty surrounding data privacy issues
 - How do GDPR data processing requirements apply to this type of contract?
 - What types of data processing provisions are required for the PP Accreditation Agreement and related program requirements?
- IRT opposed approach taken in discussion draft (data processing specification)
- Significant resources will be required to resolve open questions

Data Privacy Issues

- ◎ EPDP could provide added clarity about relevant data privacy questions, including those related to:
 - Data collection
 - Data retention
 - Data escrow
 - Third-party access to non-public registration data
 - Additional data processing provisions

- ◎ Discussions with European Data Protection Board may also provide added clarity

Next Steps

- ICANN org doesn't believe it is prudent for PP IRT to continue at its prior pace and proceed to public comment until there is added certainty surrounding data privacy issues
- ICANN org is evaluating the most appropriate path for addressing these issues
- Work will continue on unfinished items that are not related to data privacy as we work to gain added certainty surrounding open data privacy issues
