2. Administration of the ccNSO

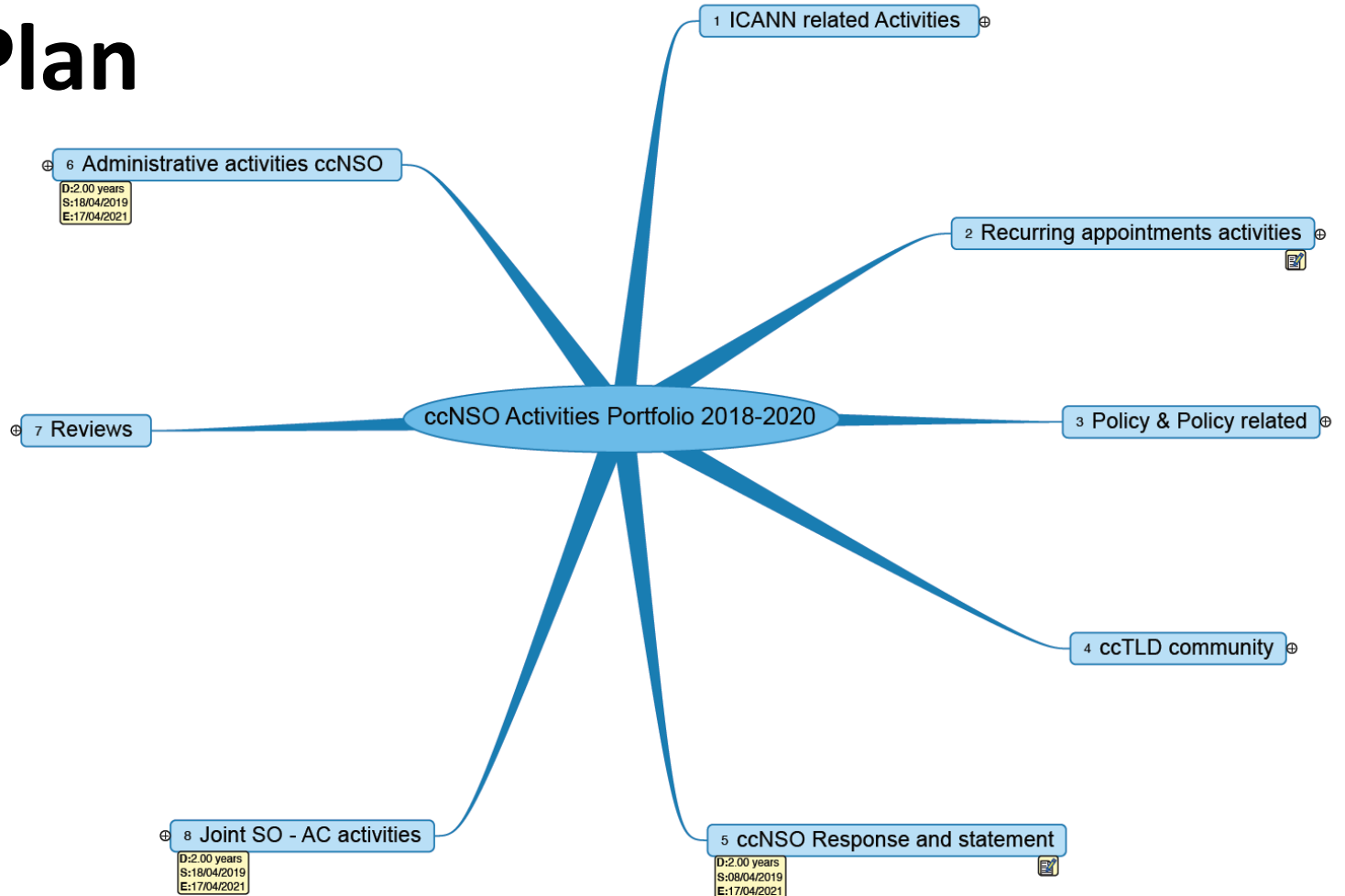

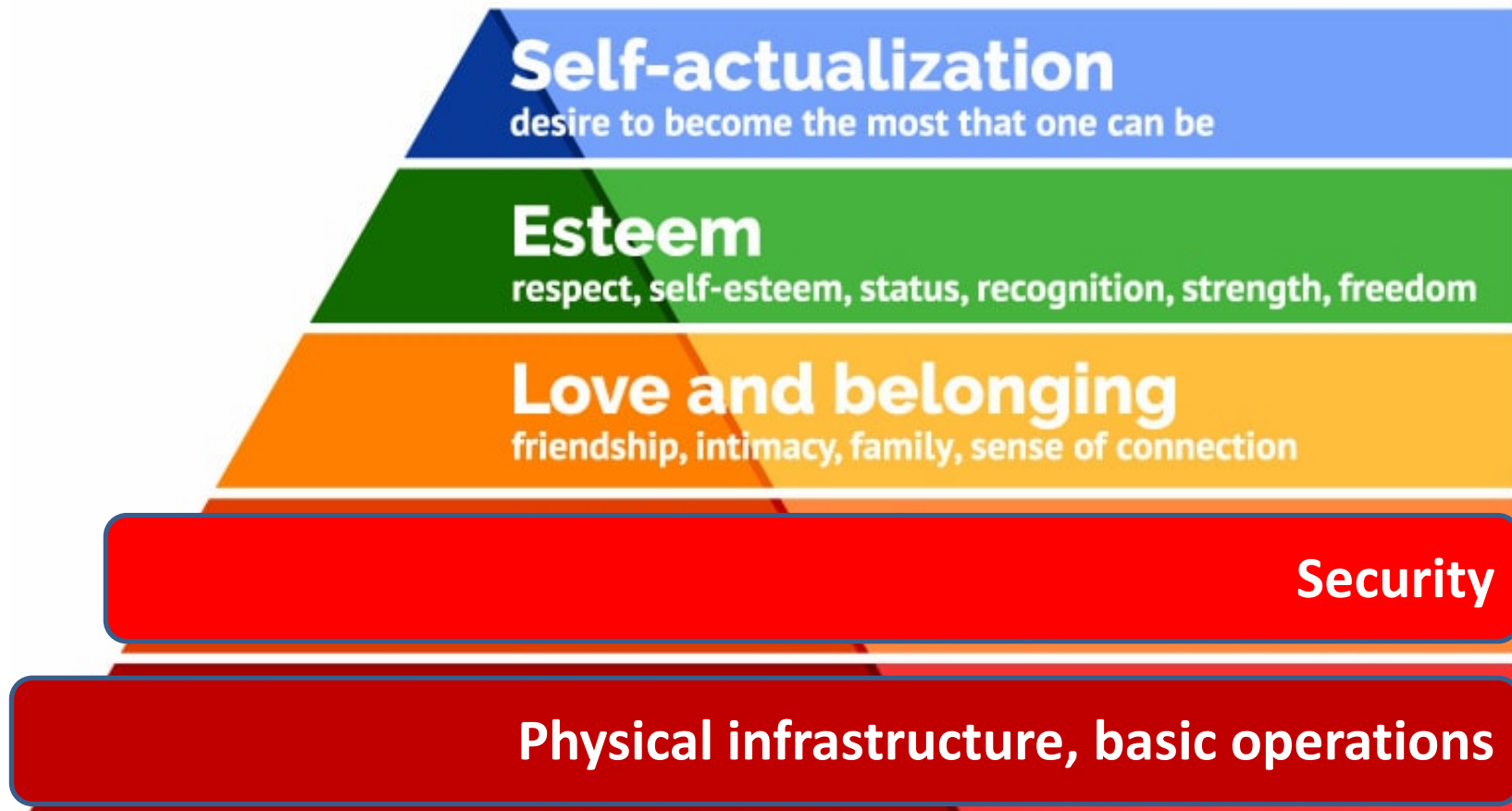
Maslow's Hierarchy of Needs



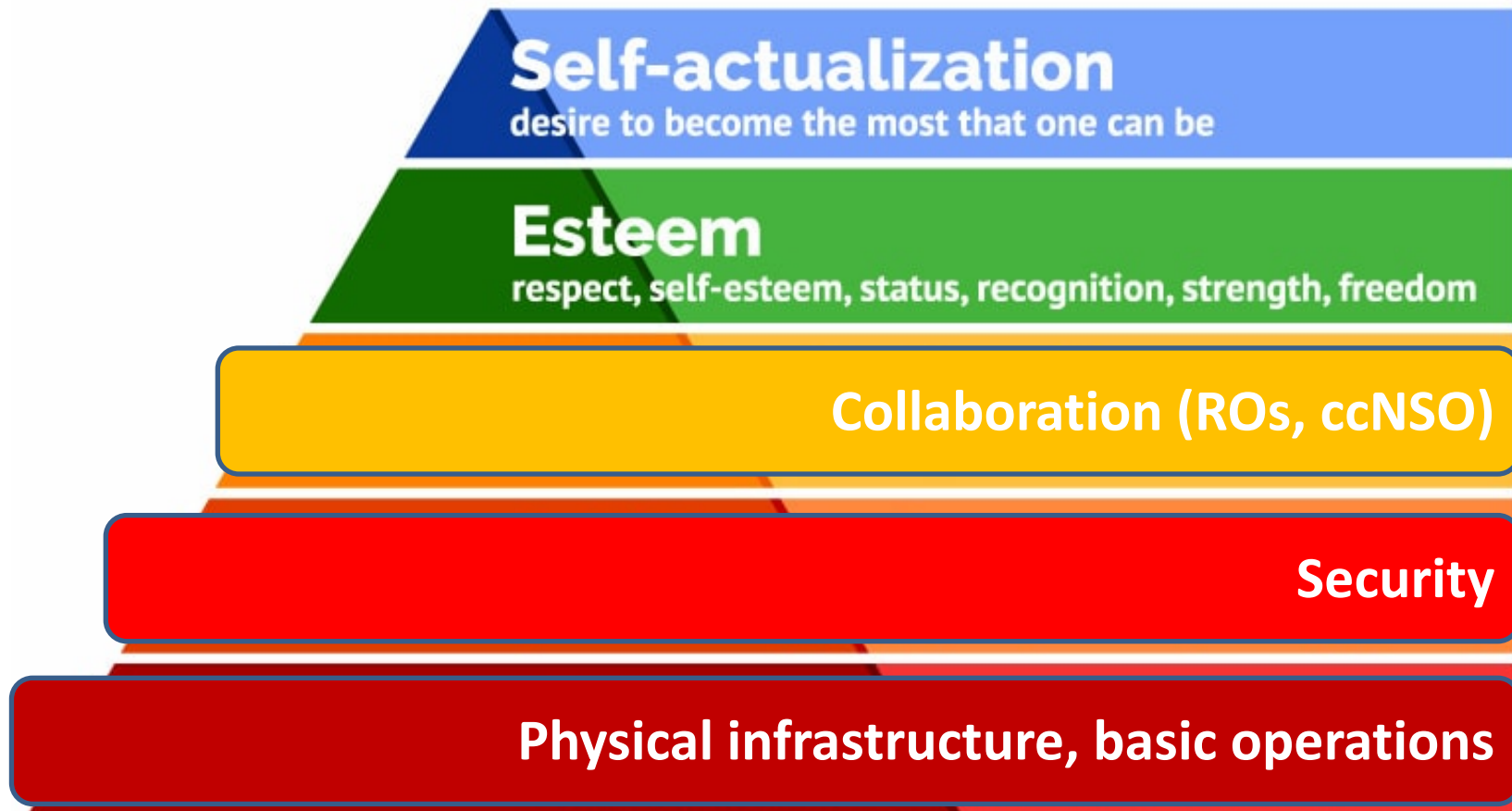
Hierarchy of ccTLD Needs



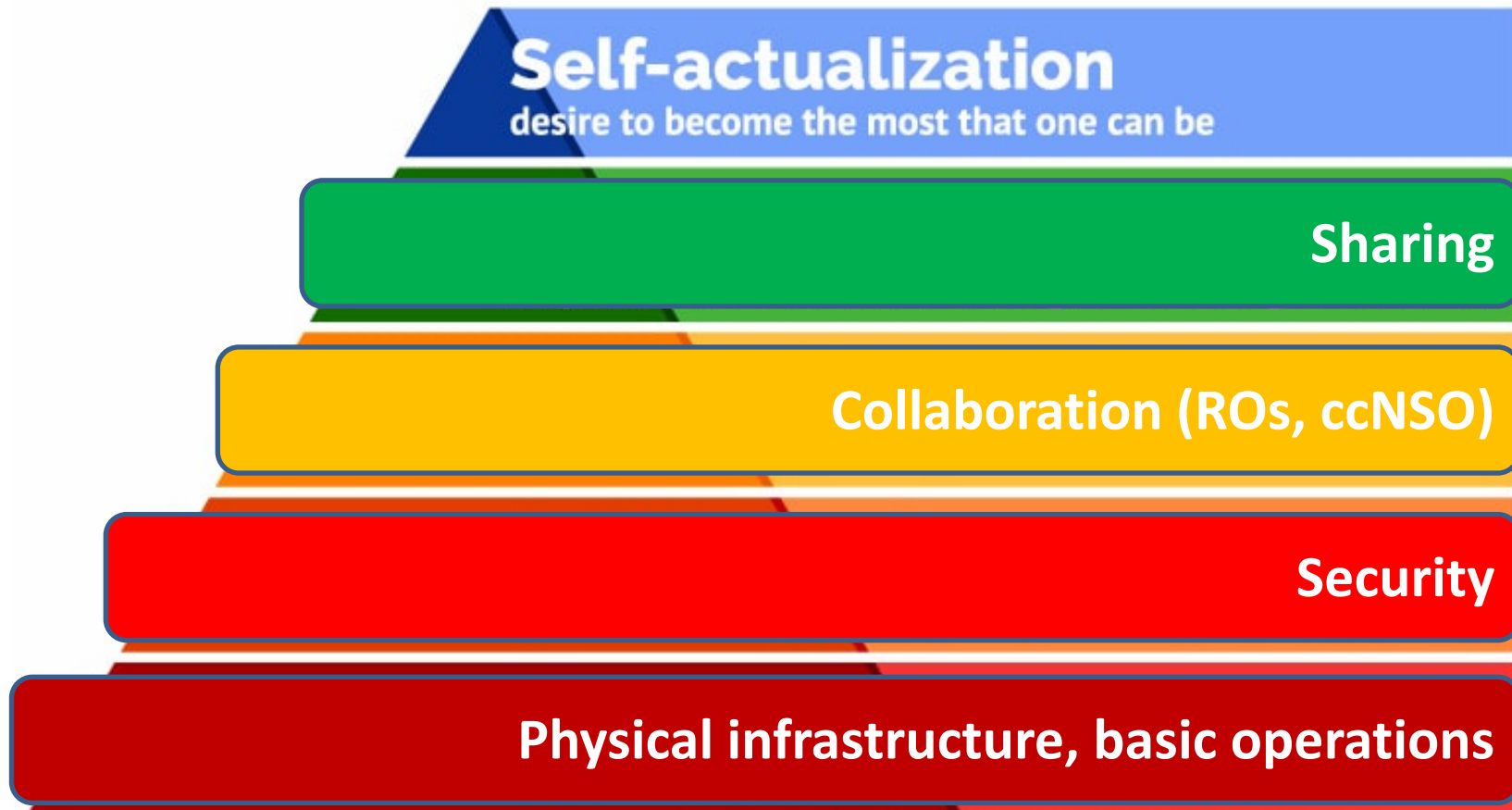

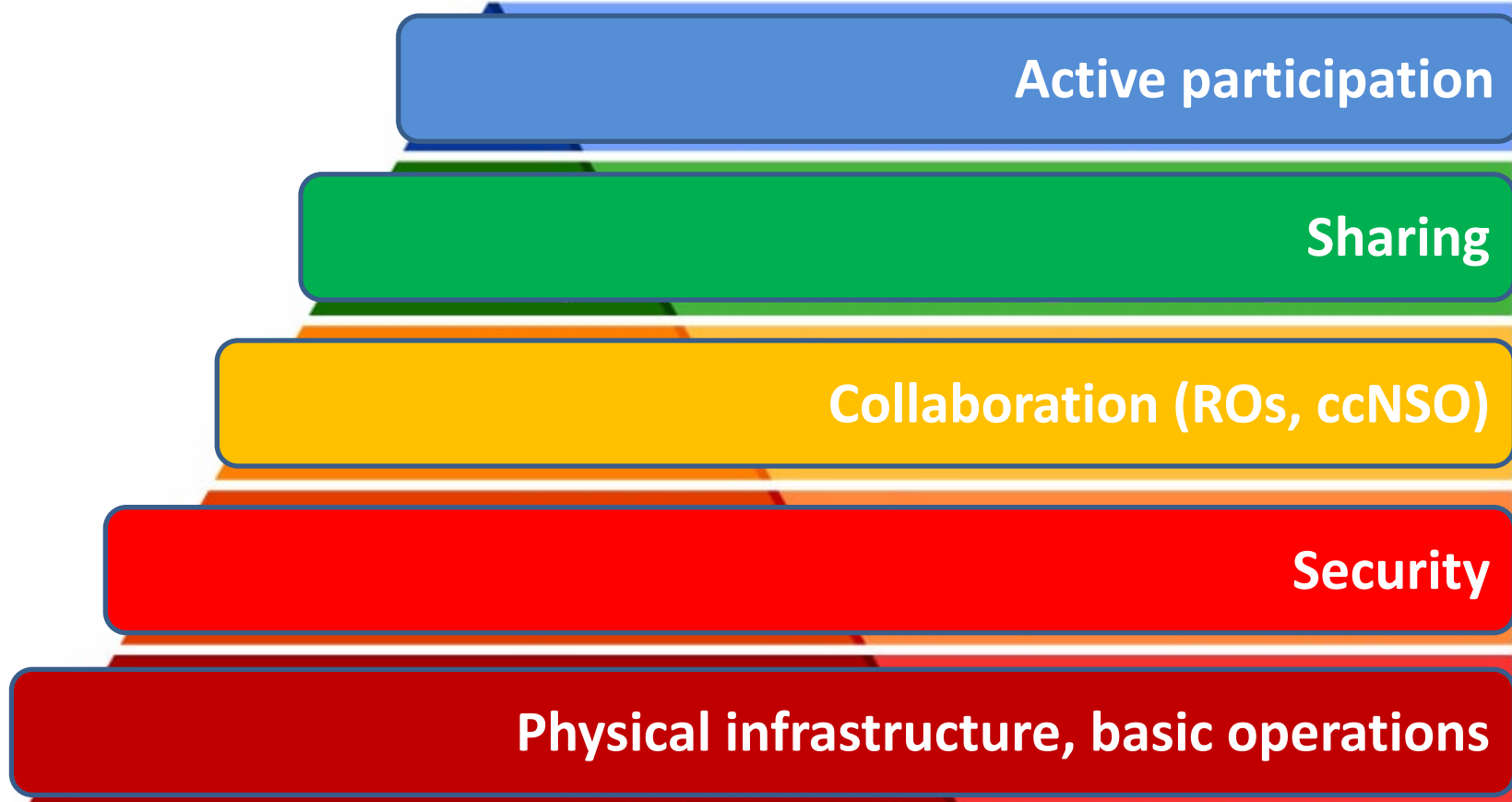
