Build Capacity


Help transform the DNS and Internet industry in Africa by facilitating capacity development and cultivating an environment for an Africagrown domain name industry and business.



State of the African DNS Market (Africa DNS Market Study - 2016)

Registries

52 functioning ccTLDs

Registrar Market

- 27 countries have only one Registrar: usually the Registry
- 13 countries have a fully competitive Registrar market

Registrant Market

- Approximately 5 million African domains (ccTLD & gTLD) in total
- 4.4 domains / 1000 population
- Value of \$52 million p.a.
