
#### Governance of the ccNSO - Sources:



In accordance with ICANN Bylaws, Article 10, Section 10.3(k)



#### ICANN Bylaw Change - IDN ccTLDs



\* Successfully evaluated IDN ccTLDs for total countries and territories (as of May 2020)

#### Milestones:

2013 - Recommended changes to Bylaws (ccPDP2)

Apr 2013 - ccPDP2 adopted by the ccNSO Council

Aug 2013 - supported by ccNSO Membership vote

Jun 2019 - General agreement the Roadmap

Nov 2019 - Policy session at ICANN 66

Feb 2020 - Change request submitted to the ICANN Board

Sep 2021 - Refined and re-submitted to the ICANN Board

May 2022 - Board adoption

#### Changes:

Allow IDN ccTLDs become ccNSO members.

Voting rights: 1 vote (country/territory)

New role: Fmissaries.



#### Administrative Updates to The Rules (Description)

#### Add to Glossary:

Representative - Each ccTLD manager may designate in writing a person, organization, or entity to represent the ccTLD manager in matters relating to the ccNSO ("Representative"). In the absence of such a designation, the person, organization, or entity listed as the administrative contact in the IANA database shall be deemed to be the designate of the ccTLD manager by whom the ccNSO member shall be represented.



- **Emissary** - the Representative selected by the ccTLD Manager in accordance with Section 10.4(e) of the ICANN Bylaws shall be the Territory's emissary ("Emissary") for the purpose of voting in the specific cases enumerated in Article 10 & Annex B of the ICANN Bylaws and the Internal Rules and Internal Procedures of the ccNSO.





#### Administrative Updates to The Rules (Description)

#### **2.1 Electronic Vote by the members:**

- A vote shall commence five (5) calendar days after the notification of the proposed matter to be voted upon, and the vote shall stay open for a period of fourteen (14) calendar days. The quorum rule for voting applies unless otherwise specified.
- The Electronic Vote by the Members shall be reserved for Emissary voting. Each Emissary, regardless of the number of ccTLD managers within the relevant Territory, is entitled to cast a single vote in any round of any voting.



#### Administrative Updates to The Rules (Description)


#### 2.2 Quorum rule for Electronic vote by the members:

- The quorum shall be at least thirty-three percent (33%) of the total number of possible Emissary votes and at least the vote of three (3) Emissaries per ICANN Region.
- In the event the quorum is not met, a second vote will automatically start 14 calendar days after closure of the invalid round of voting. The results of the second vote will only be valid if the quorum is met. In the event the quorum is not met again in the second, final round of voting, the Members will be deemed to have abstained and the status quo remains.

#### Administrative Updates - ccNSO Council Election Procedure (Bylaws)

#### 3.3 Eligibility to Nominate and Second + 5.1 Nomination Process:

- Only the Representative from a ccNSO member will be able to nominate & second candidates.
- A Representative from a ccNSO member may self-nominate, but then not allowed to second their self-nomination. Self-nominations must be seconded by two Representatives from two ccNSO Members from different Territories in the Region.



#### Administrative Updates - ccNSO Council Election Procedure (Bylaws)

#### **5 Call for Nominations:**

Any ccNSO Representative may nominate an individual to serve as a ccNSO Council member representing the ccNSO member's Geographic Region. Nominations must be seconded by another ccNSO Representative from a different Territory, from the same Geographic Region.



#### Administrative Updates - ccNSO Council Election Procedure (Bylaws)

#### 6 Elections:

In such an election, a majority of all the Emissaries in the Geographic Region entitled to vote shall constitute a quorum, and the selected candidate must receive the votes of a plurality of those cast by the Emissaries from the Geographic Region. The voting will be conducted as follows: the voters are required to indicate on the ballot the candidate of their choice, and the winner is the candidate who receives the plurality of the votes.





#### <u>3.4 Summary of the Election Process + 4.2 Nomination and Election Timeline</u>:

In establishing the timeline, the Election Process Manager, should take into account:

- The duration of the nomination process.
- The need for Q&A session before the voting starts (preferably during ICANN's AGM meeting).
- The voting process and potential run-off election.
- Conclusion of the election process 2 months prior the meeting when the newly elected Councillors take their seat on the ccNSO Council.

#### Administrative Updates - Nomination ICANN Board Seats 11 & 12

#### 3.2 Call for Candidates:

Each ccNSO member through its Representative may nominate and/or second one or more candidates. The nomination and/or secondment shall be published.

If a ccNSO member nominates a second candidate, **only the first nomination will be valid** and published as such. Following nomination(s) by that ccNSO Member will be made public, but with a clear note "not valid". For avoidance of doubt:

- Nominating and seconding of candidate(s), is limited to ccTLD Managers who are members of the ccNSO on the date the call for candidates is published.
- If the organization or entity listed in the DNS Root Zone Database as ccTLD Manager, nominates and seconds one and the same candidate, only the nomination is considered valid and the secondment for the same candidate shall be deemed invalid.



#### Administrative Updates - Nomination ICANN Board Seats 11 & 12

#### 3.5 Election and run-off election

- The election should not start earlier than two weeks after the closure of the Q&A session.
- All ccTLD Managers who are Member of the ccNSO one day prior to the day the formal Election Notice is published may vote through their Emissaries.
- The Nomination Process Manager will issue an email to the Emissaries.
- The Candidate(s) that receive the plurality of the votes cast by the ccNSO members, shall be the Candidate(s) who is(are) elected to be nominated by the ccNSO Council.
- In the event the plurality of the votes cast is "None of the Above" the Nomination Process shall be terminated.





#### 3.4 Presentation of Candidate Statements:

At the time designated in the Timeline and after the first ICANN meeting following the closure of the Due Diligence verifications, ccNSO members and others will be provided the opportunity to meet and question the Candidate(s). This session will preferably take place during a Members meeting during an ICANN meeting. The meeting will be chaired by an independent person who has no affiliation or connection with any of the Candidate(s).




# Part A (Statement of Interest)

#### Part A - Statement of Interest (SoI) - Transparency

**Statement of Interest.** A declaration by a Member or Participant in which the Interests of the individual are recorded that may affect the individual's judgment, on any matters to be considered by the ccNSO Group.

For purposes of this Guideline "Interests" are those specified interests, relationships, arrangements, and affiliations that may affect the judgments of the Member or Participant in their involvement in the ccNSO Groups.
