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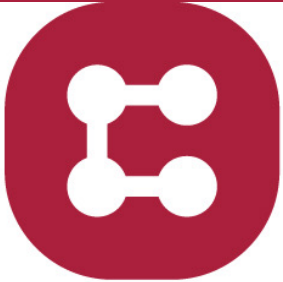
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CIRA'S RESPONSE TO CANADA'S DIGITAL DIVIDE

Canada's Digital Divide

- Discrepancies in access and speeds between urban, and rural and remote areas of the country.
- Limited competition in the Canadian telecommunications sector.
- Broadband development lags behind regulatory objectives.
- Actual speeds received often don't live up to promised performance.

How CIRA helps: Grants

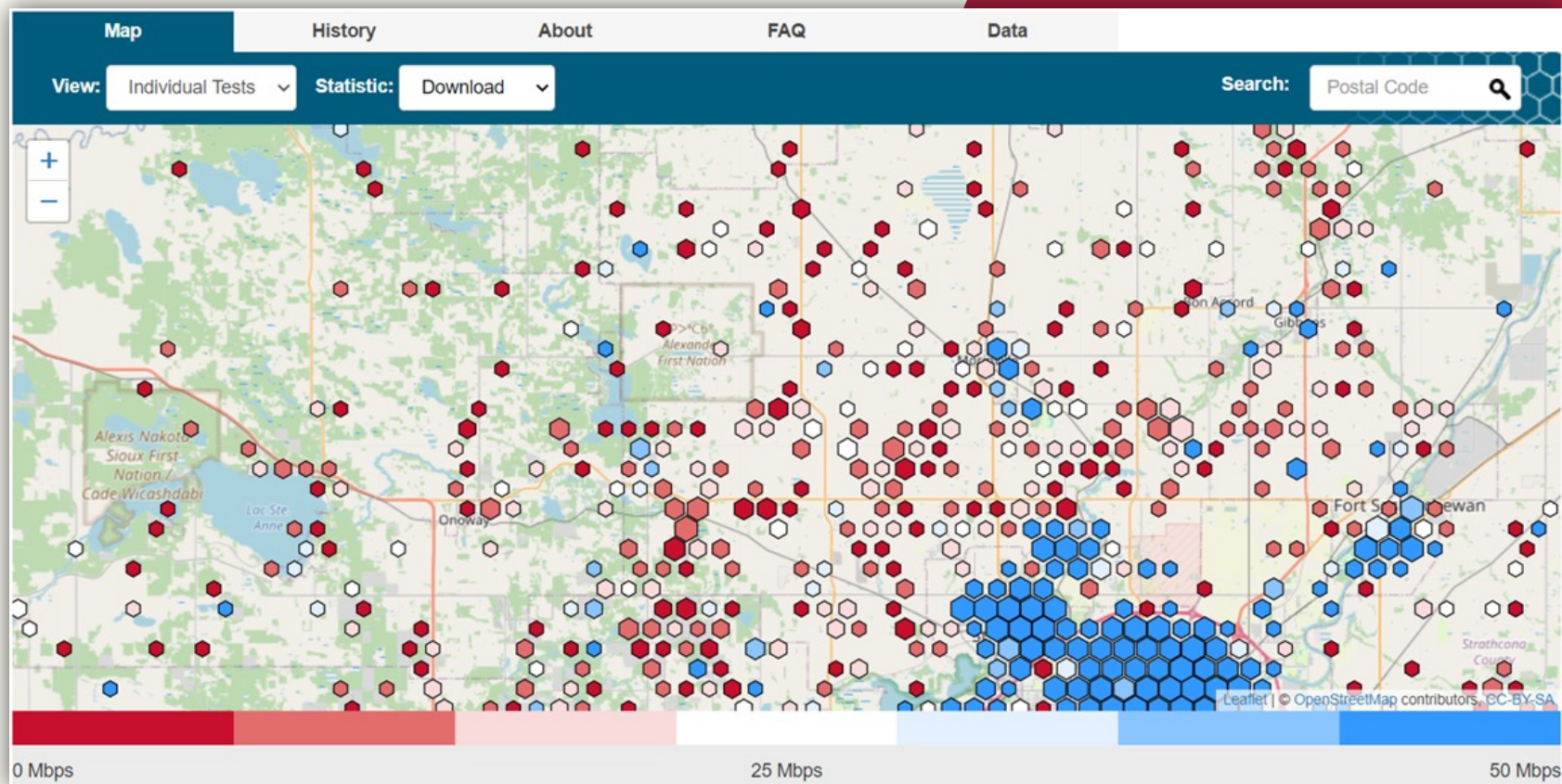
- Community-led internet projects to build a resilient, trusted and secure internet for all Canadians.
- Since 2014, CIRA has provided \$10.45 million in funding for 201 projects across Canada.
- Includes funding for broadband infrastructure initiatives in underserved regions of Canada (e.g, Malahat Nation, Port au Port Peninsula in Newfoundland, remote and rural communities in Winnipeg's Metropolitan Region).
