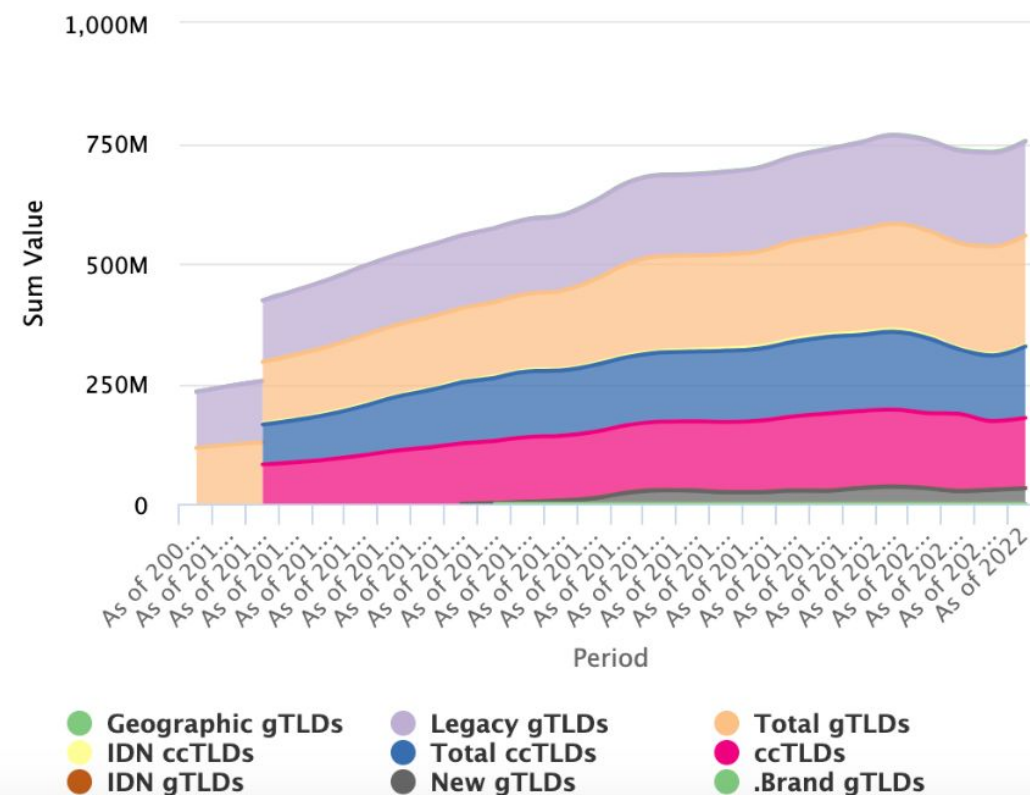

ICANN Domain Name Marketplace Indicators - 2023 Oct 12

Geographic gTLD. New gTLDs qualifying for ICANN classification as “geographic.”

ICANN Wiki

A Geo TLD is a top level domain name category created by ICANN denoting geographical, geopolitical, ethnic, social or cultural representation

GEOTLD Group

geoTLDs are a type of TLDs that are intended to serve a geographic place, language or culture. They include:

- Geographic names such as .berlin, .barcelona, or .africa
- Geographic identifiers such as .nyc (New York) or .frl (Friesland)
- Names of geographic origin such as .irish or .gal (Galicia)
