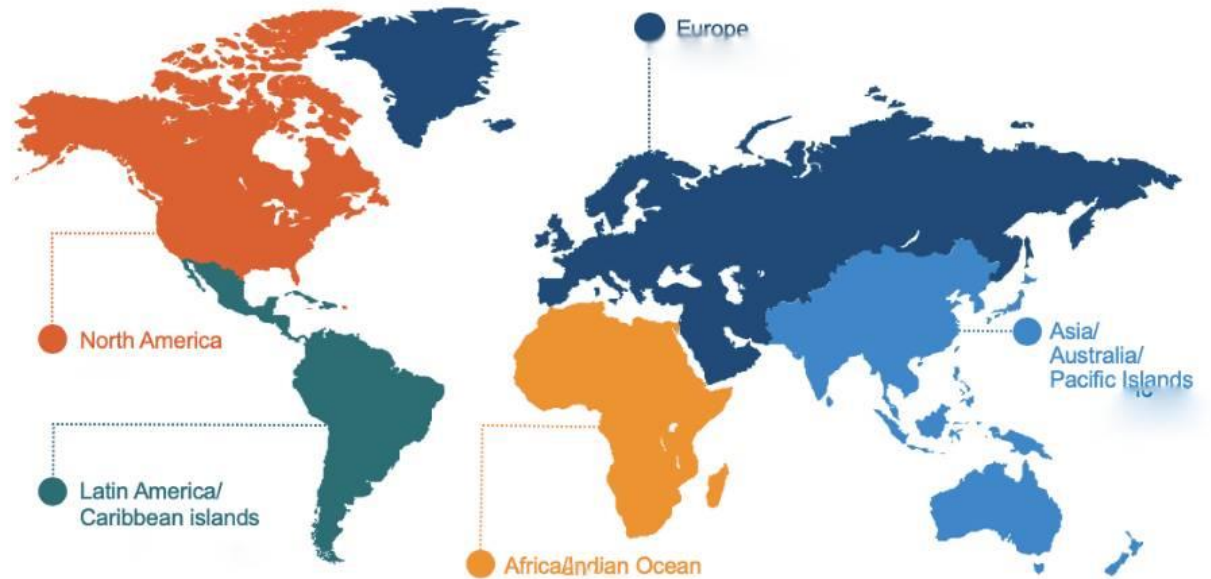
The **NCUC** advocates positions on domain name-related policies that protect and support noncommercial communication and activity on the Internet.

is to ensure that the voice of non-commercial users is heard at ICANN.

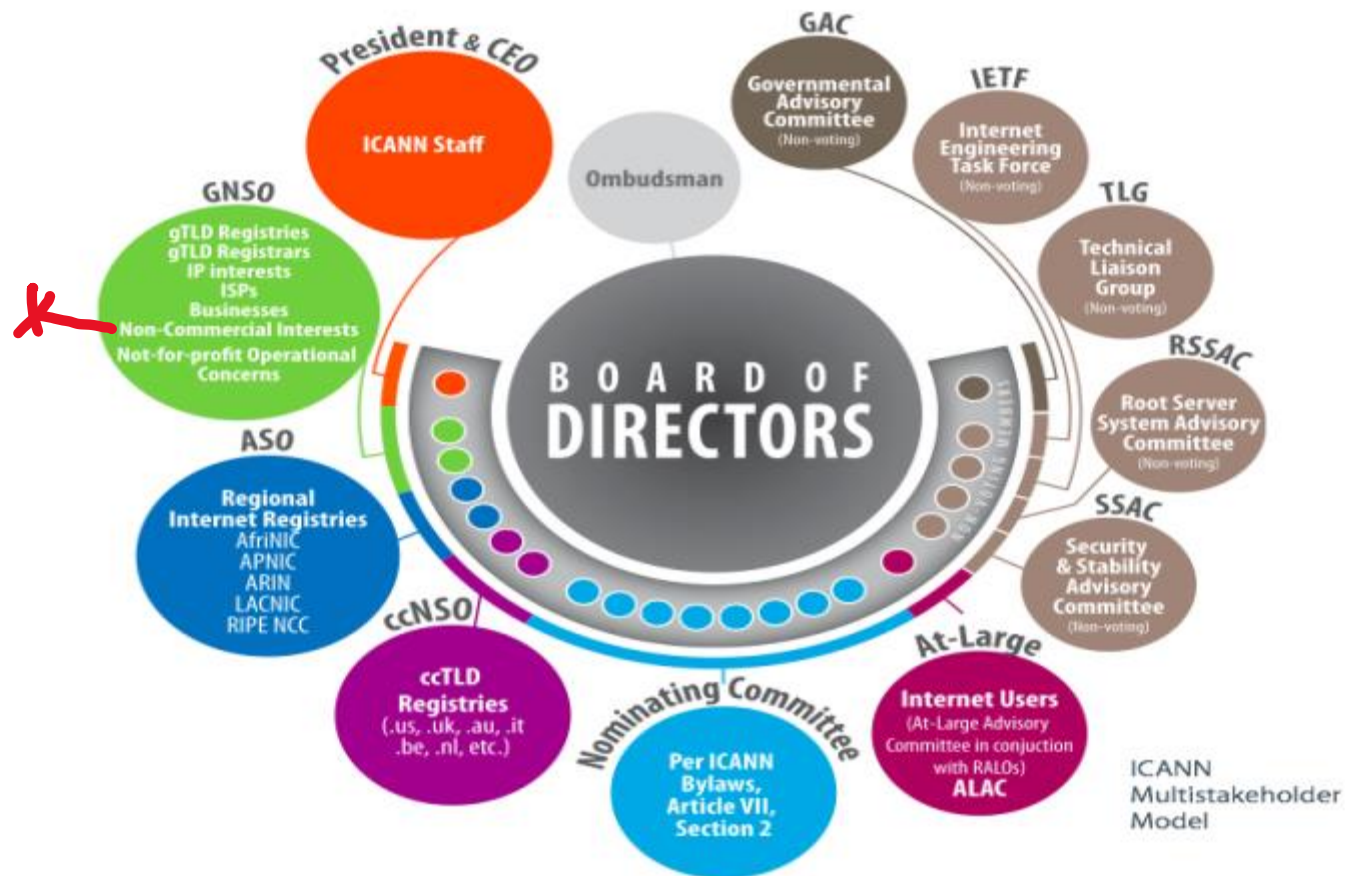
## Membership strength
