- To invite new partners to join the research initiatives

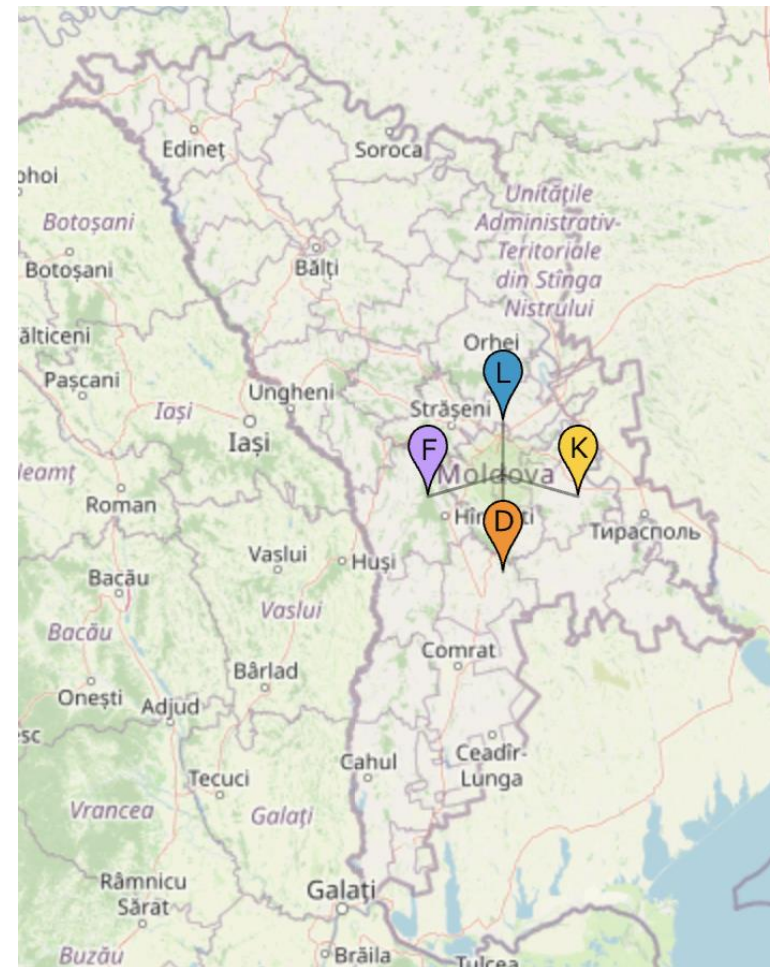
Current status:

- IMD became an internationally supported initiative for technical enthusiasts
- It now plays a role of a platform which connects researchers with data owners on a local level
- IMD became a great opportunity for local researchers to raise their visibility and share outcomes
- The goal is to help technical community to take informed decisions based on the deep understanding of how Internet works technically

Moldova

During the IMD ICANN and RIPE NCC unveiled the local peering and DNS landscape, showing that up to 95% of all DNS queries had been served abroad in the neighboring countries

After that Moldova authorities and operators community elaborated plan how to cover Moldova with Root DNS service, which resulted in 4 additional root instances placed in local autonomus systems



Next steps and plans for future

- Expand IMD beyond RIPE NCC service region
- Invite more partners and local researchers
- Expand scope of the initiative, add more topics meanwhile preserving pure technical focus of the initiative
