About At-Large and RALOs

At-Large Community

- Within ICANN, the At-Large Community acts on the interests of Internet users

Regional At-Large Organizations (RALO)

- There are 5 geographic regions with recognized organizations



- MOUs with ICANN
- Made up of ALSes and Individual Members in their Geographic Region
 - Independent organizations – ALSes
 - Individual Members

About RALOs - ALSes

ALSes accredited by ALAC, to ensure and promote the regional users participation in matters within ICANN's remit

- Including: Professional societies, academic and research, community networking, consumer advocacy, Internet Society chapters, computer users and Internet civil society organizations are invited to apply and join

The RALOs these organizations representing the interests of Internet end users in each region

The RALOs help to get end user voices and opinions heard within ICANN's bottom-up, consensus-based multi-stakeholder approach in ensuring stable and secure operation of the Internet's unique identifier systems

About RALOs – ALSes (Cont'd)

At-Large Community

- (263) ALSes
- (212) UIMs
- (17) Unaffiliated Observers
- Recommends delegates to the NomCom

About the ALAC

A small subset (15 members) of the At-Large Community

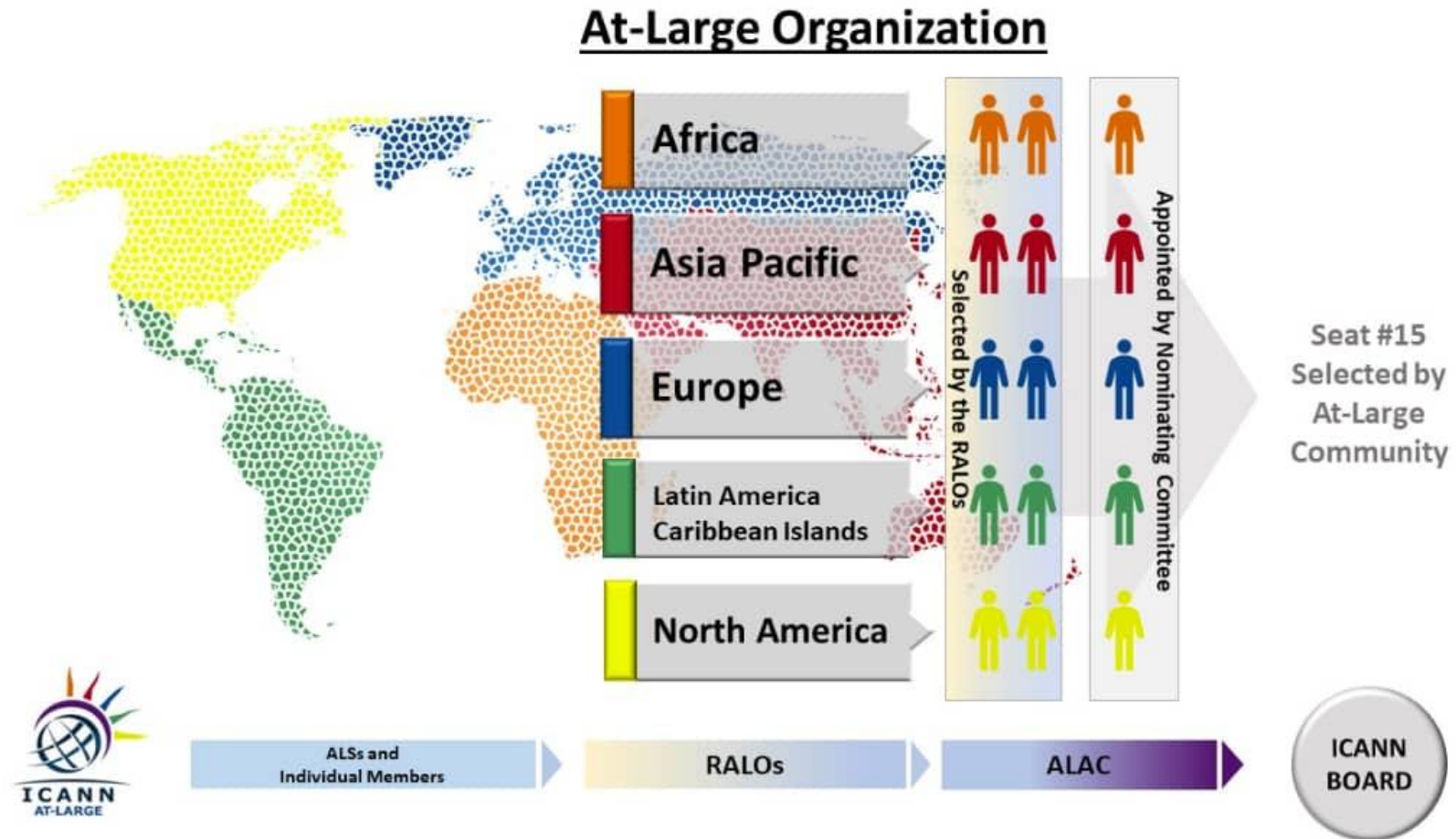
Includes 4 Liaisons to the GAC, GNSO, ccNSO, SSAC

Advises on the activities of ICANN including Internet policies and operations

Appoints delegates to the NomCom - RALO recommended

Seat 15 on the ICANN Board of Directors is selected by the ***At-Large Community***
