Board Regional Diversity Calculation

1. When the 2025 application window was opened on January 15, there were no geographic restrictions for the ICANN Board
 - This has changed with the recent Board elections by the ccNSO and GNSO-Contracted Parties House
1. The NomCom will no longer be evaluating Board candidates from North America
 - The NomCom has added a note in the Application Portal to reflect this change
 - An email will also be sent to all applicants
1. Impacted North American applicants who possess dual citizenship will be given the opportunity to re-apply or revise their submissions
