The process so far

- ICANN Supporting Organisations and Advisory Committees meeting discussion (ICANN80)
- “How We Meet” Discussion Group formed - community members and ICANN staff subject matter experts (December 2024)
- Meetings of the community discussion group (Jan-March 2025)
- Draft proposals at ICANN82 Seattle (Prep Week session, Plenary session, ccNSO session)
- Initial Report (31 March 2025) - options for community feedback
- Public comment process between ICANN82 and ICANN83 (closed 19 May)
- ccNSO Council developed and lodged a submission
- Public Comment Summary Report (2 June 2025)

Highlights

ccNSO Council submission

Community Forum Duration

- Supports shortening to 5 days, with safeguards for meaningful participation.
- Encourages parallel sessions and full use of Prep Week.
- Recommends structured Board-community engagement.

Meeting location strategy

- Supports cost-effective venues with regional rotation.
- Emphasizes criteria: accessibility, affordability, visa access, and safety.
- Cautions against repeating inequitable venues.

Online shift policy

Supports policy for automatic online shift in emergencies, with:

- Clear criteria
- Transparency
- Community input

Warns against using policy as a cost-saving shortcut.

Virtual-Only Meetings

- Opposes converting any regular ICANN meeting to fully online.
- Opposes adding a fourth meeting, even virtually.
- Concern: Erosion of trust, participation, and engagement.

Financial Sustainability

Endorses cost-efficiency without reducing participation.

Supports efficient venue use (e.g., co-location, ICANN offices)
