Diverging Topics of Interest

Operational Relationship with ICANN

- gTLDs: Contracted parties (Registry Agreements)
- ccTLDs: Non-contracted (some accountability framework or exchange of letters)

Policy Frameworks

- gTLDs Primarily within ICANN's policy remit
- ccTLDs: Operate under national legislation and sovereign public policies

Relationship with National Governments

- ccTLDs: Direct and formal interactions, often integrated into national internet governance structures
- gTLDs: Indirect involvement, primarily through ICANN processes and multistakeholder model

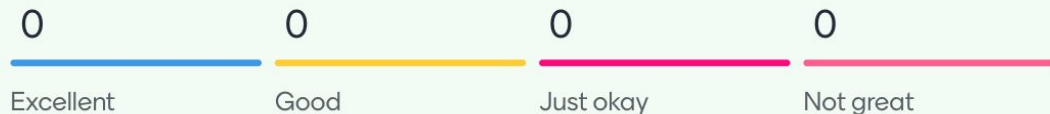
