IANA Functions Stewardship Transition - Process and Next steps

- + 6 June 2014 – Process to Develop a Proposal and Next Steps posted online, echoing community feedback:
 - + Renamed the "Steering Group" to "Coordination Group"
 - + No role for the Chair of the ICANN Board and Chair of the GAC in selection of members;
 - + Direct representation (self-selection);
 - + Eliminated the distinction between affected and non-affected parties;
 - + Revised composition to ensure greater balance and representation, including indirect stakeholders.

Process and next steps

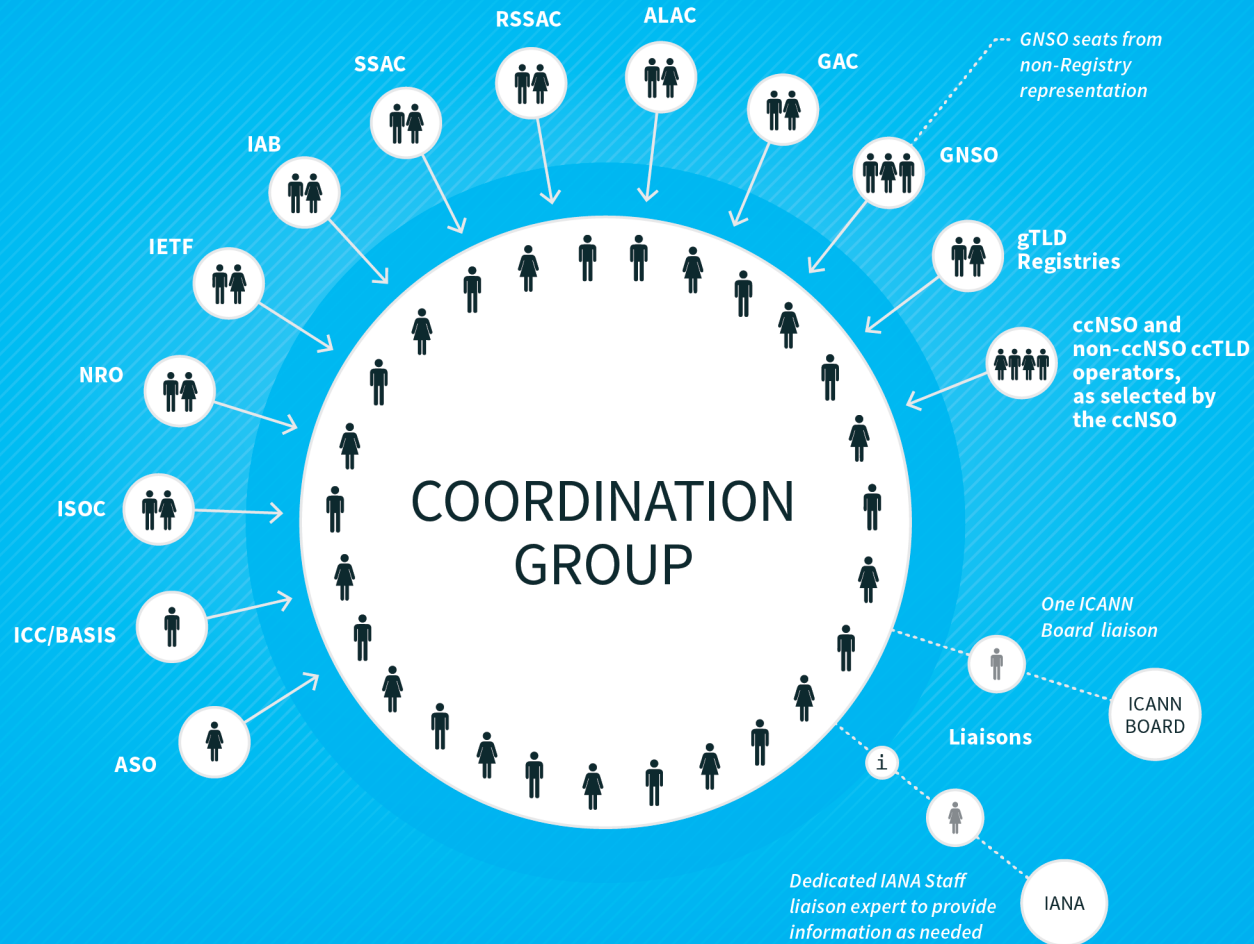
- + Revisions to draft process echoing community feedback:
 - + Non-prescriptive about the roles and responsibilities of the Coordination Group;
 - + Coordination Group will establish its own working methods and modes of operation;
- + ICANN maintains neutral role as convener and facilitator of process;
- + Coordination Group encouraged to adhere to diversity standards as they undergo internal selection processes.

Process and next steps

- + Next steps:

- + Call for names from respective communities;
- + Deadline to submit names is 2 July 2014;
- + Tentative face-to-face meeting in mid-July.

Enhancing ICANN Accountability

- + Separate interdependent ICANN community process (open to all);
- + Proposed framework for process with questions for community input published on 6 May;
- + Proposed scope:
 - + Look at contractual relationship with the U.S. Government and the **perceived backstop** with regard to ICANN's organization-wide accountability provided by that role, such as the renewal process of the IANA Functions Contract;
- + Deadline for public comment and reply period extended by one week (**27 June**) to address community requests for additional time.

Call for Input and Dialogue on the Proposed Process

- + Proposed Output would:
 - + Identify the key elements for strengthening ICANN's accountability to address the absence of its historical contractual relationship to the U.S. Government;
 - + Prioritize those elements for development and/or refinement; and,
 - + Set forth a timeline and mechanisms for the implementation of the improvements identified.

Enhancing ICANN Accountability – Proposed Process

- + Proposed process:

- + ICANN Accountability Working Group is proposed to coordinate community dialogue and prepare report for public dialogue and input and Board consideration;
 - Working group is proposed to be composed of community members selected through SO/ACs;
 - Outside subject-matter experts appointed by ICANN staff; to bring in new ideas;
 - Potential Board liaisons;
 - Sub-working groups in subject areas expected to convene within community (open participation);
 - Mode of operation should be transparency and openness;
 - Selectees to be announced by SO/ACs by 27 June.
