AROS provides a centralized location for communications between registry operators and registrars.

## **Benefits for Registry Operators**



#### **Enhanced Visibility**

All TLDs will be listed and contacting information will be broadcasted making both more visible at the same source.



#### **Two-Way Communication**

Both Registry Operators and Registrars will have the opportunity to communicate to each other through a tool tailored for their needs.



#### **Re-usability**

Registry Operators will be able to prepare a template and re-use it for all TLDs and Registrars.



#### Convenience

Key functions like e-signature and knowing that only ICANN accredited Registrars are allowed in the system will make it easier to establish relations.


#### Market of Available TLDs
