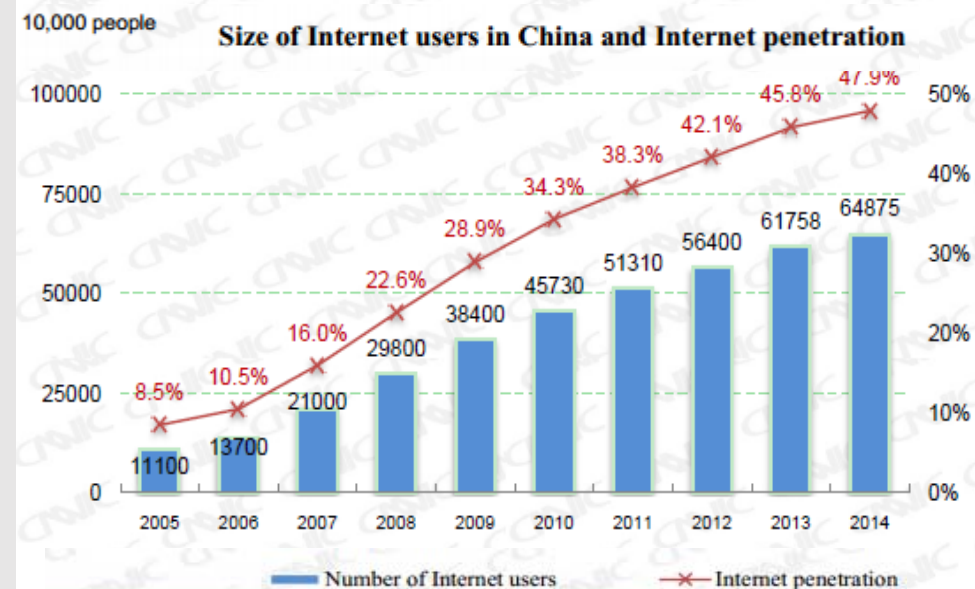

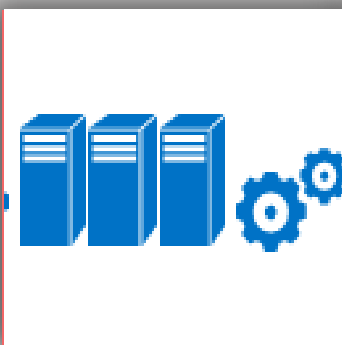
## Popularity of urban and rural internet users

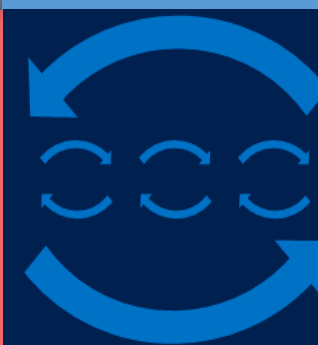

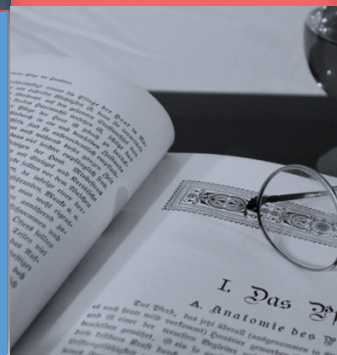

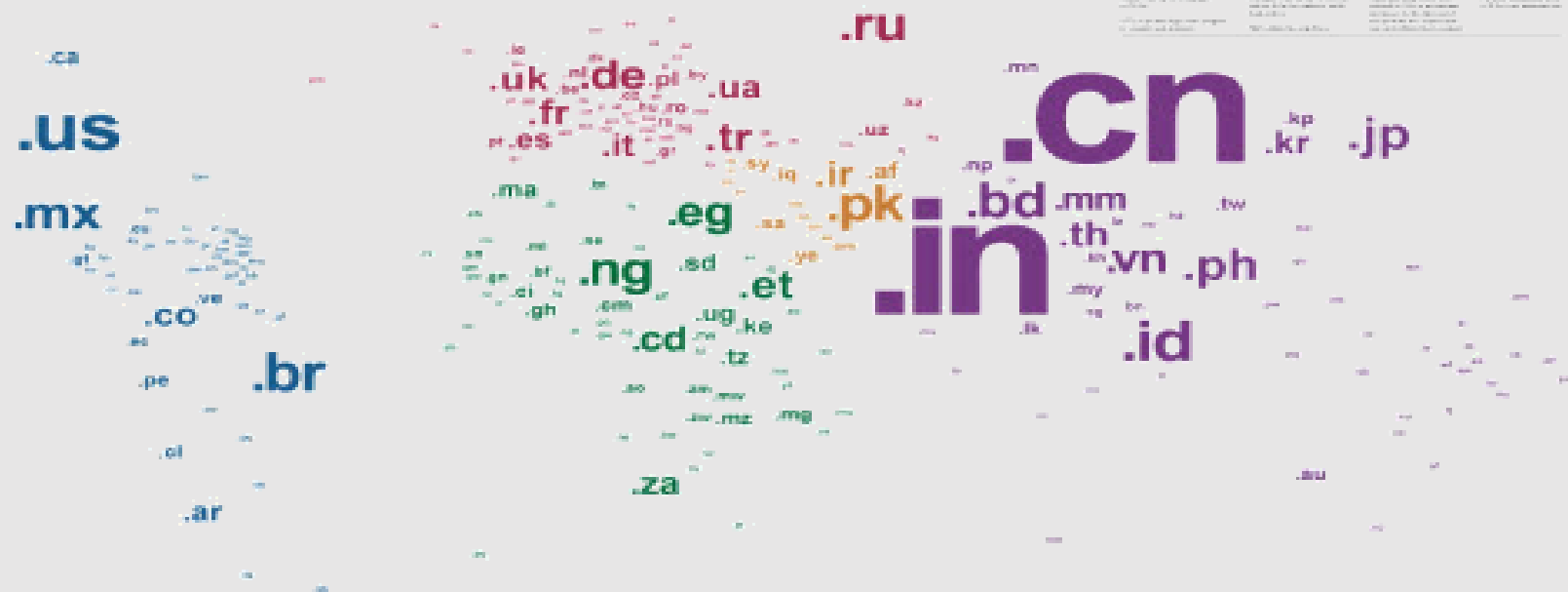

### To promote new Internet address service

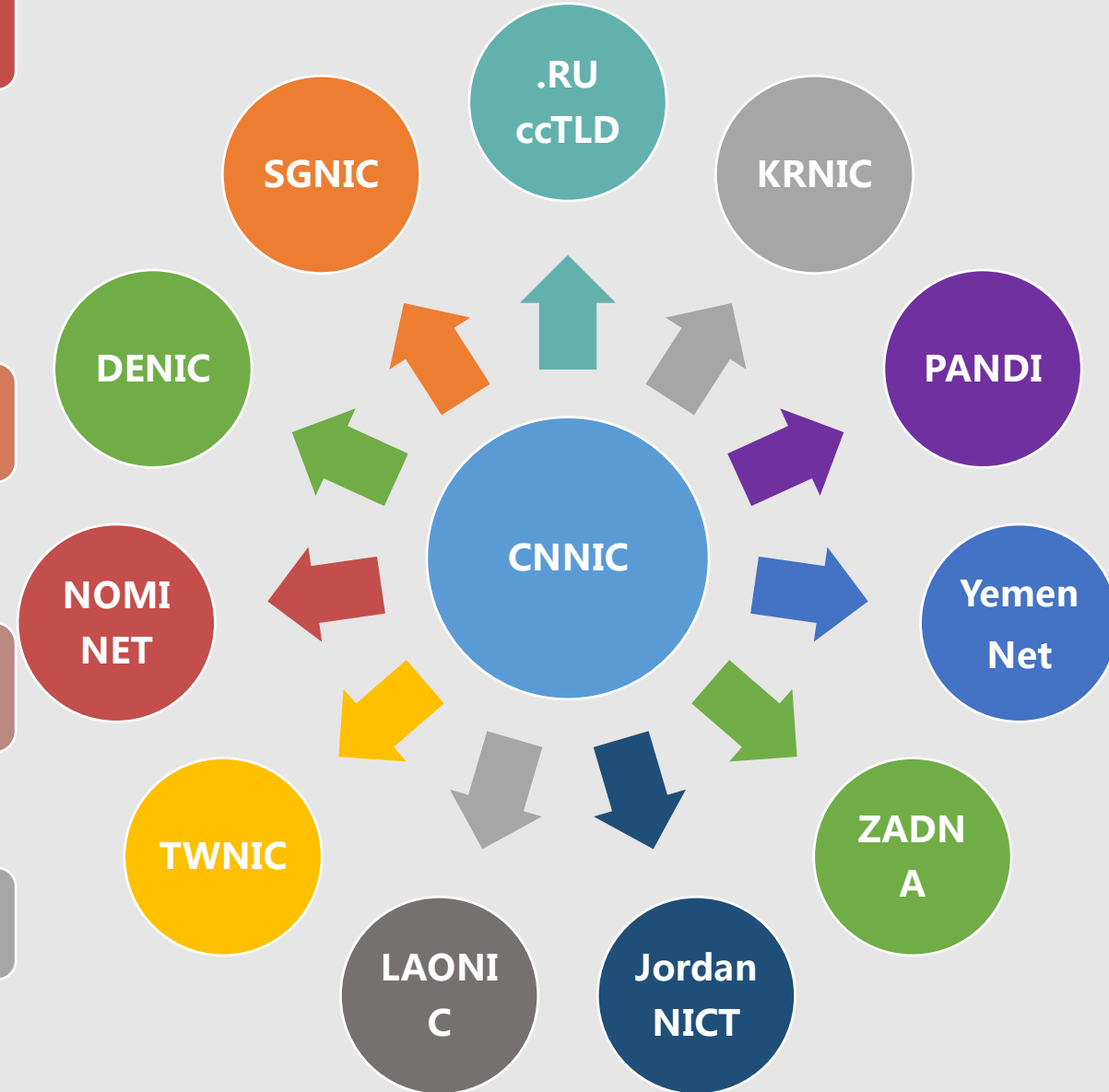
- Promoting IDNs globally

- Conduct of staff exchange programs.



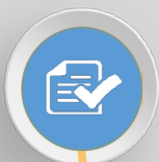

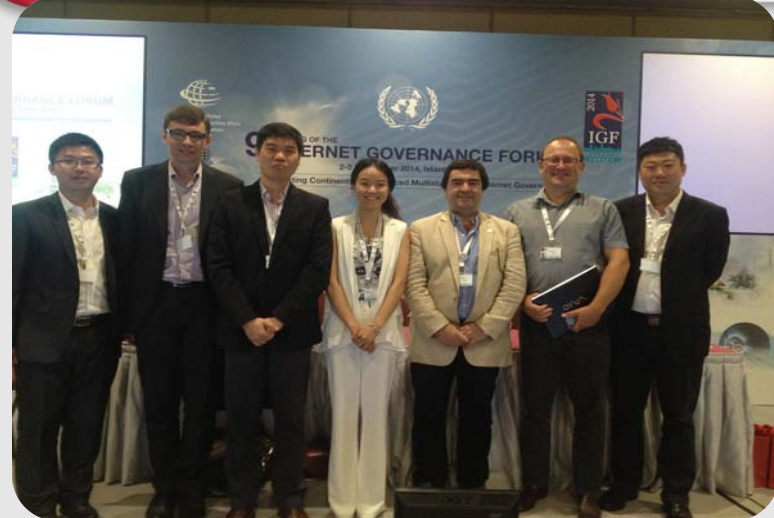
