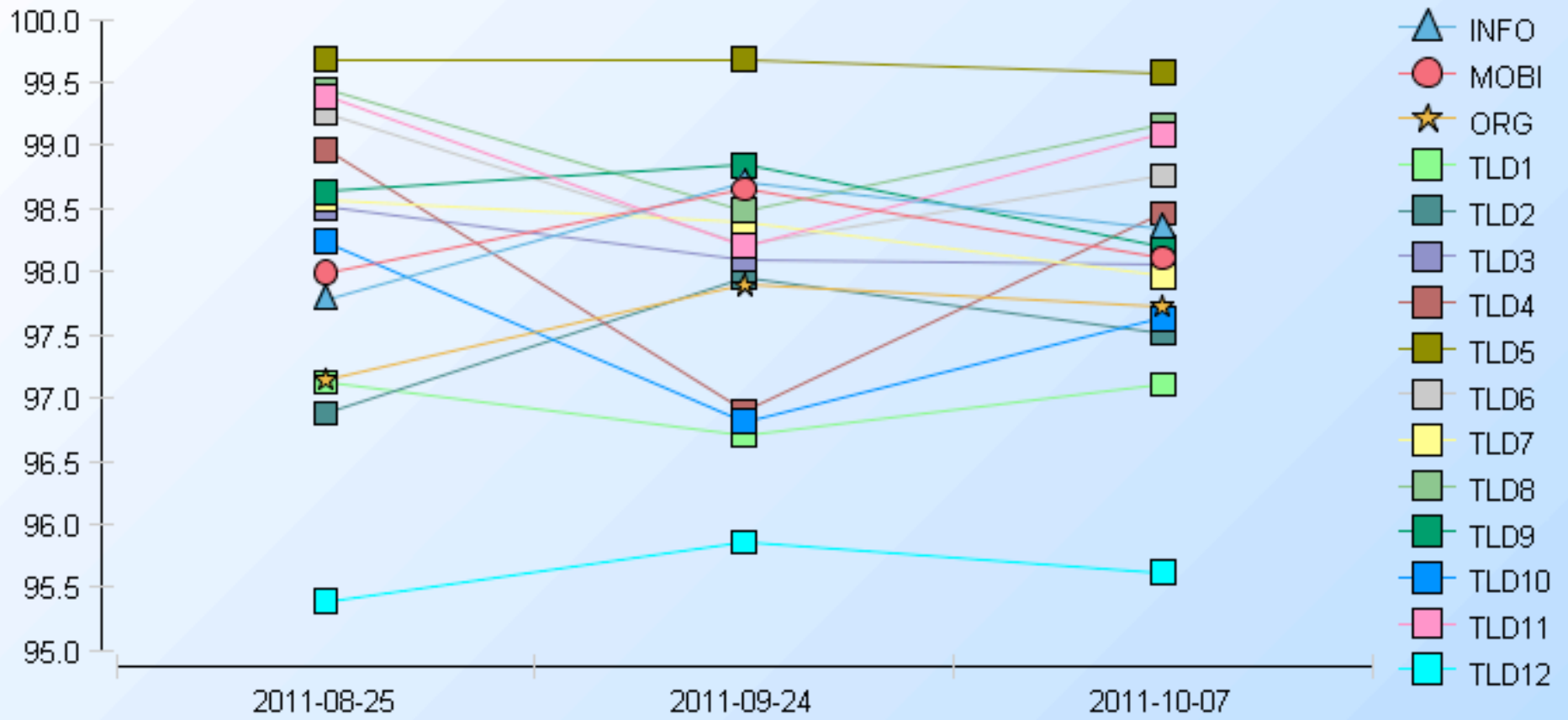


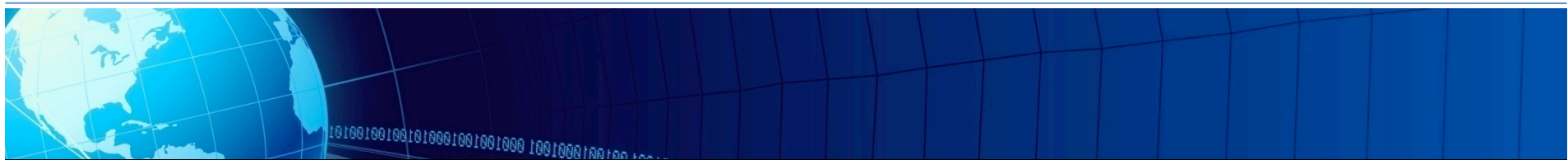
Moment in Time

- Included a peak at IPv4 versus IPv6

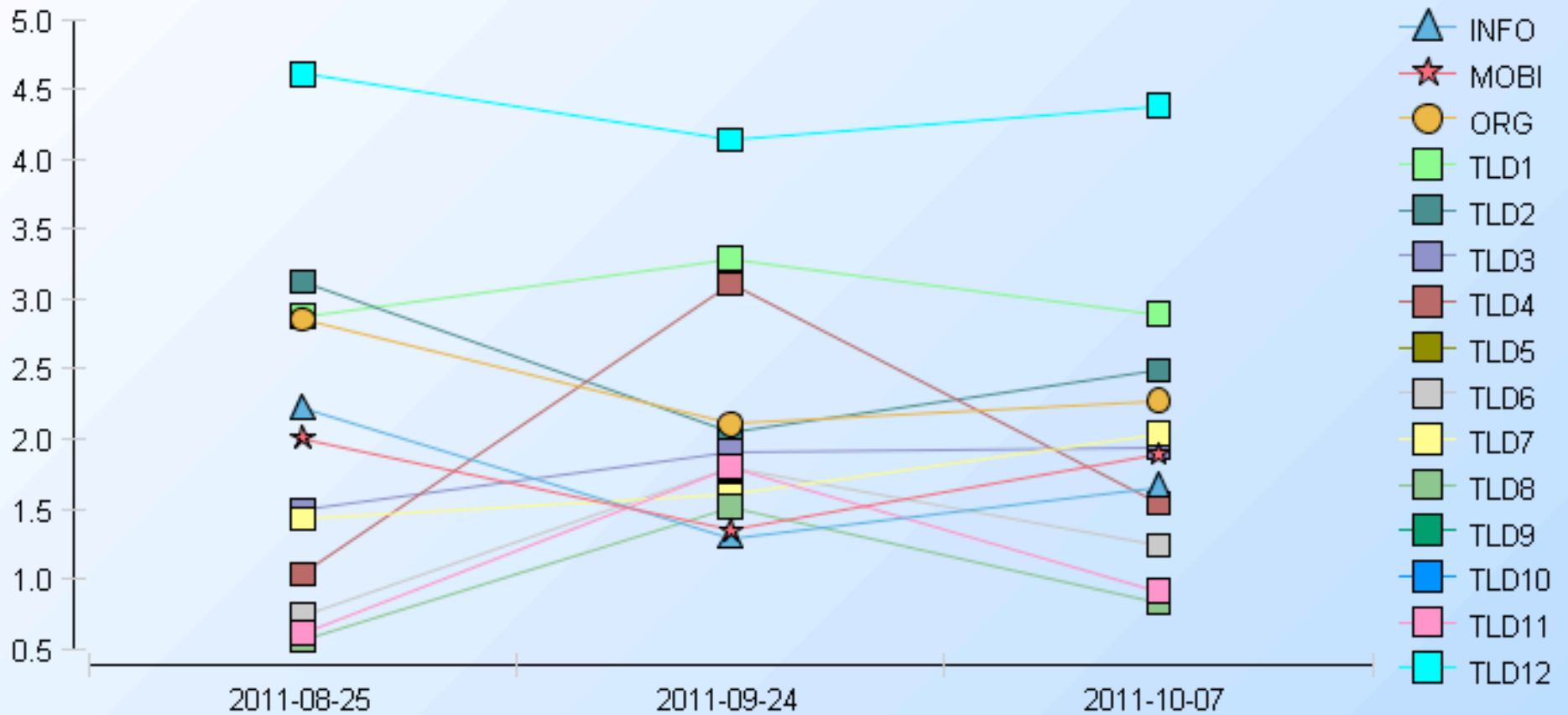


IPv4 Queries % by TLD for 3 Select Days



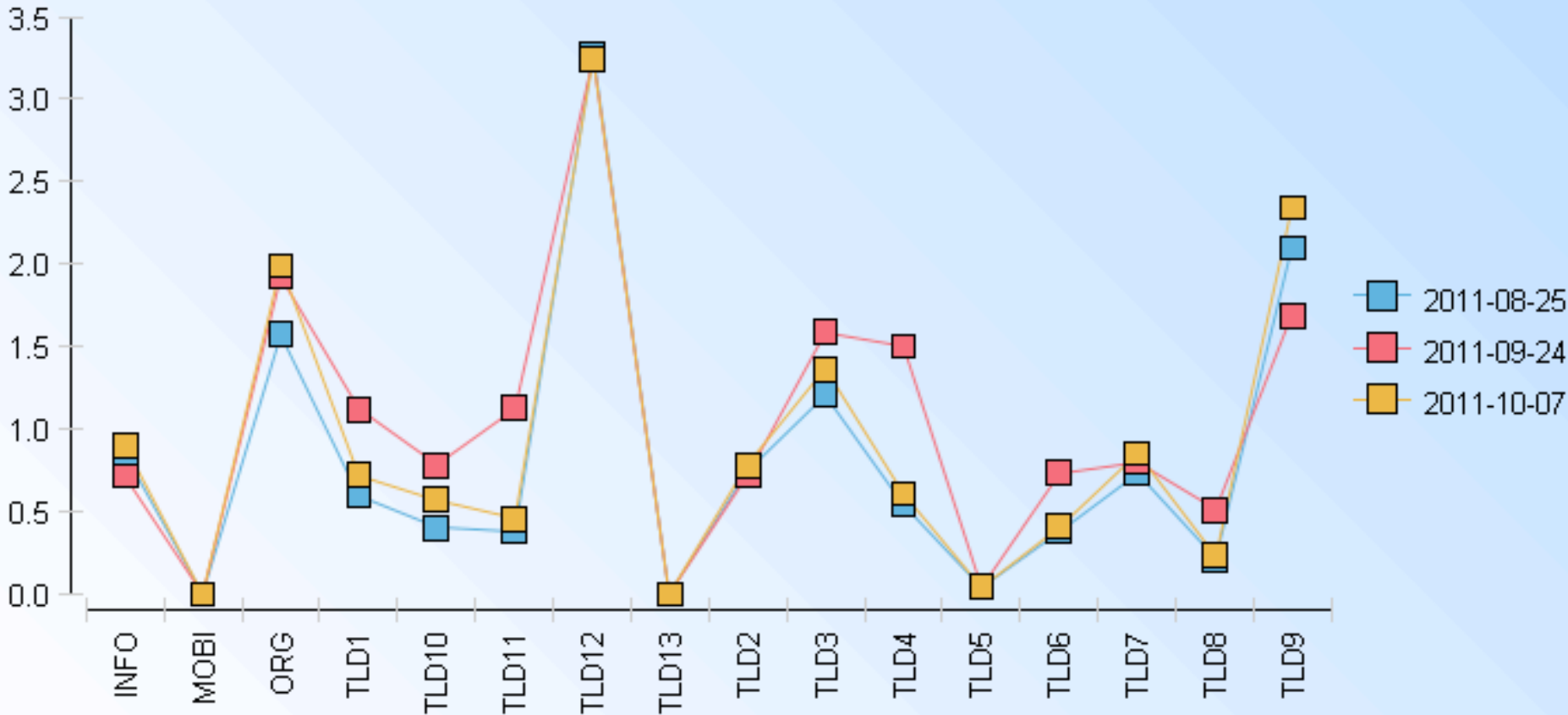


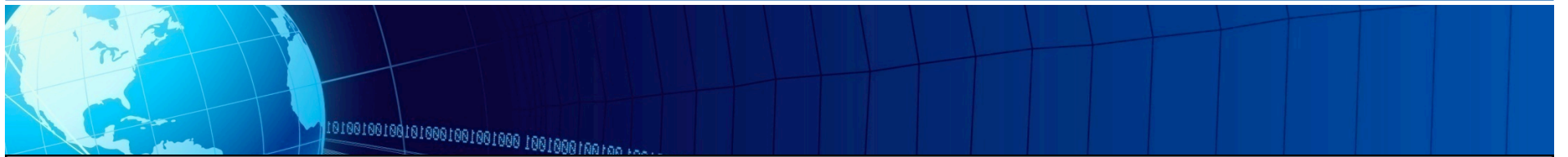
IPv6 Queries % by TLD for 3 Select Days



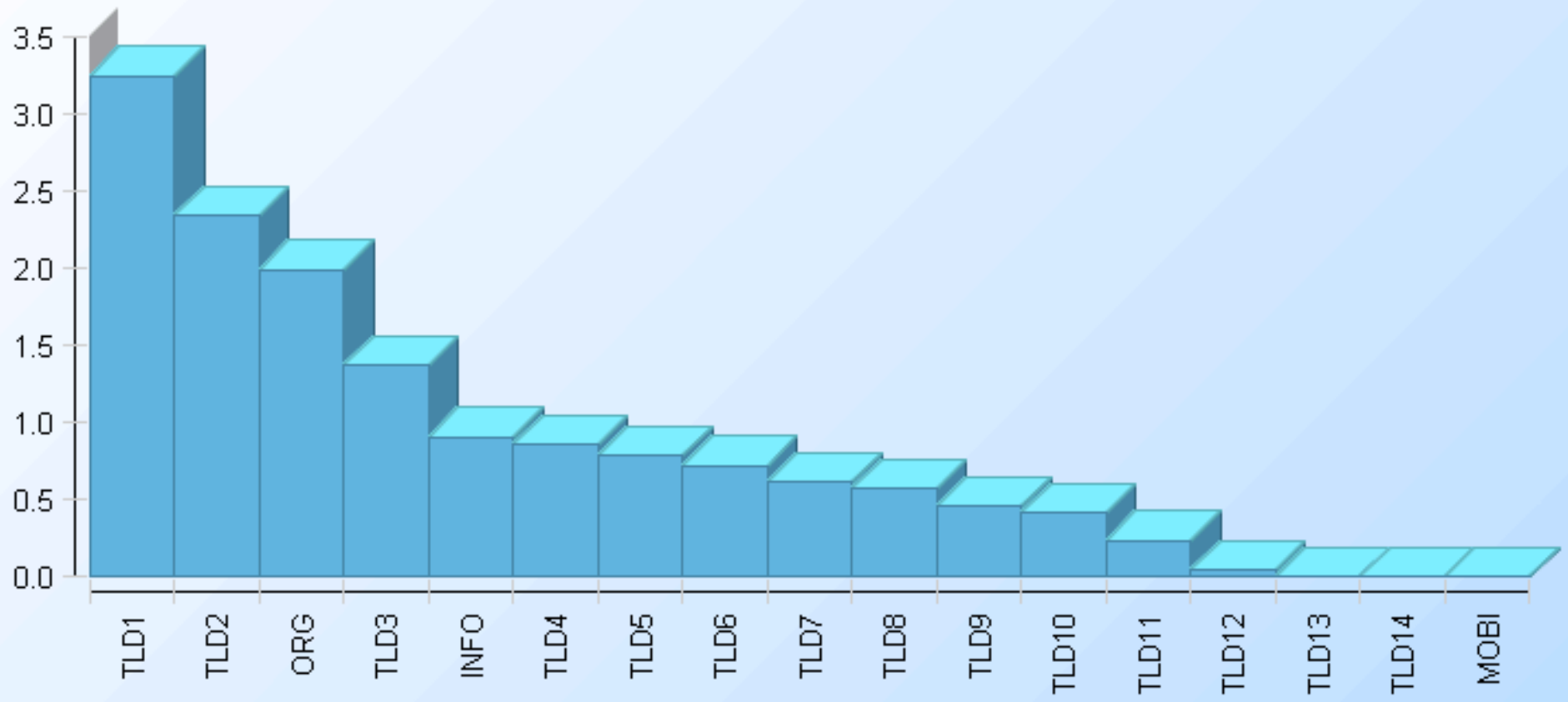


DS Queries % of Total by TLD for 3 Select Days



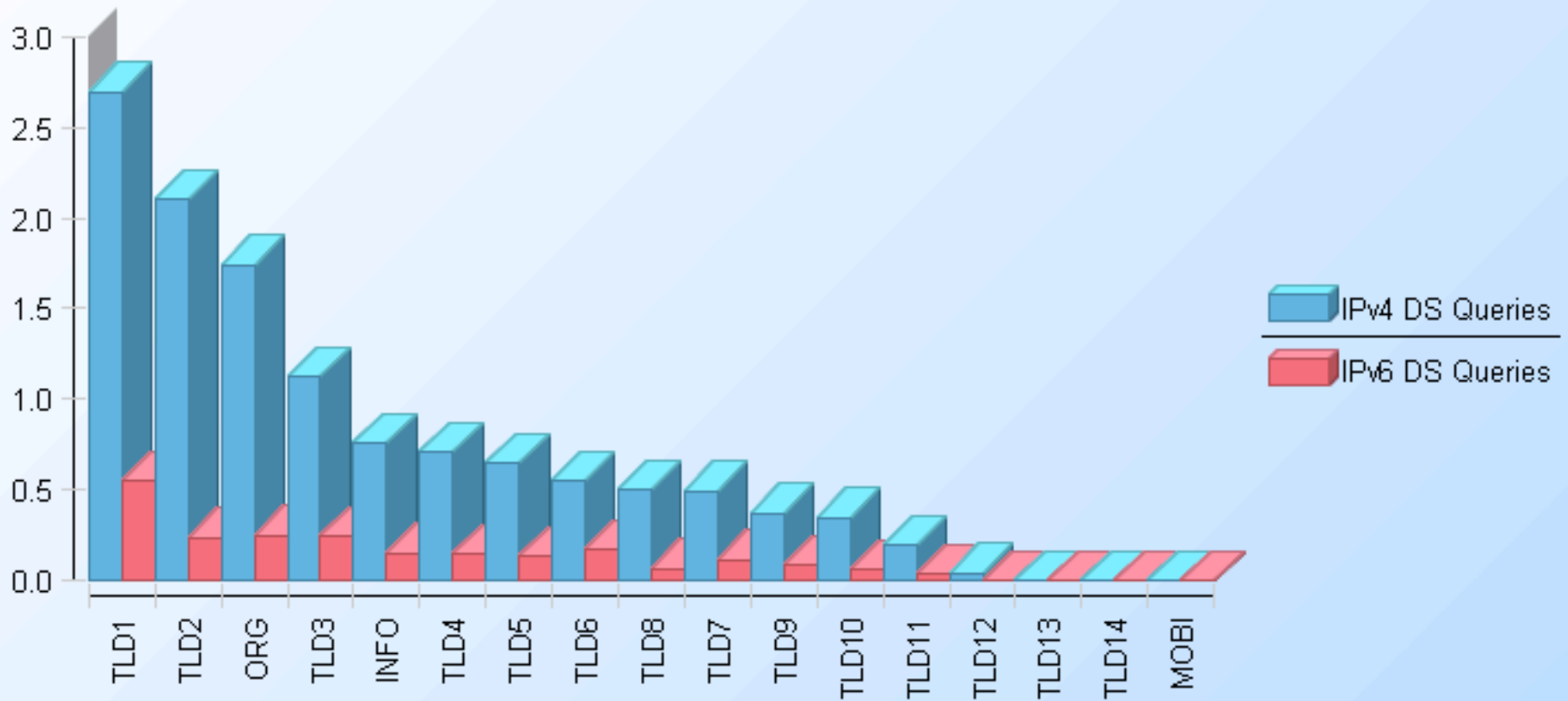


DS Queries % of Total by TLD for 2011-10-07

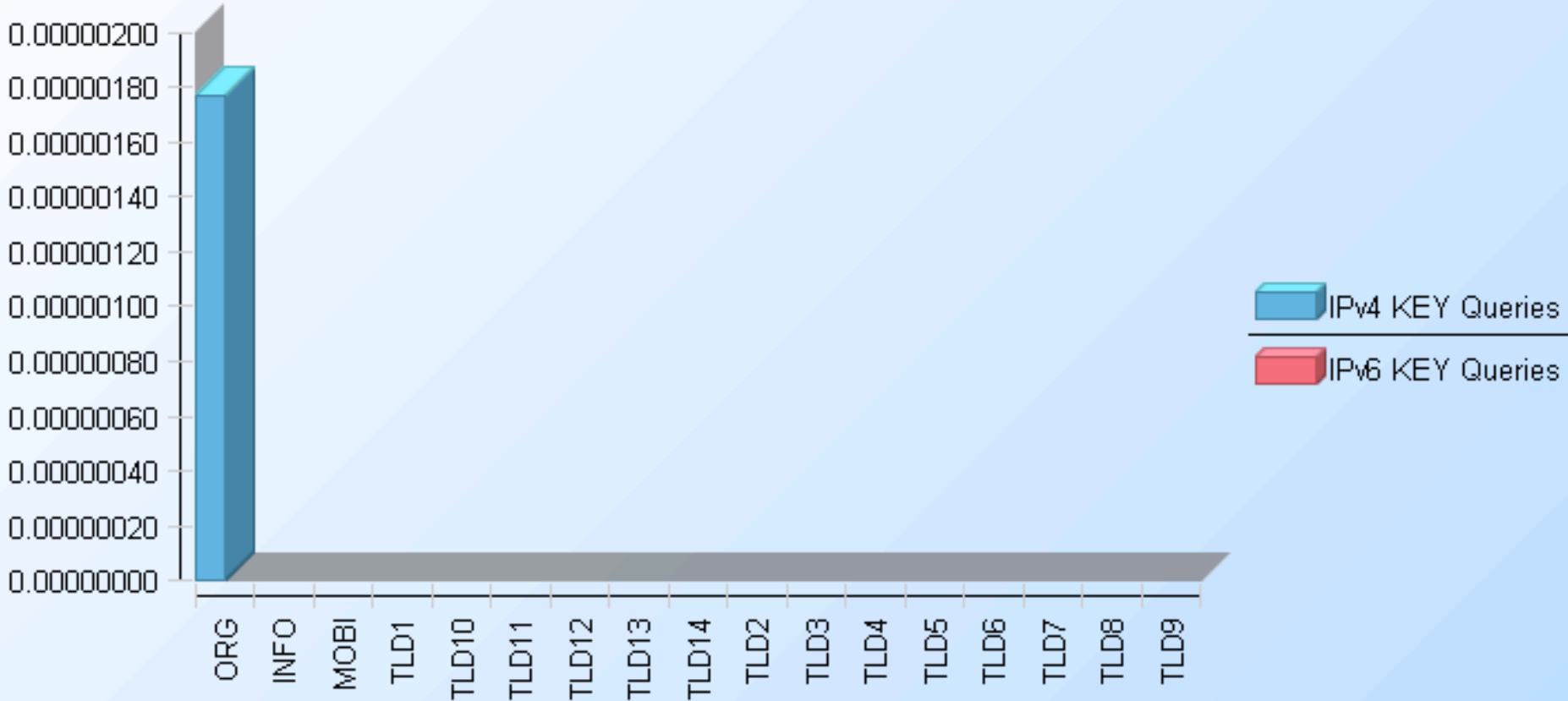




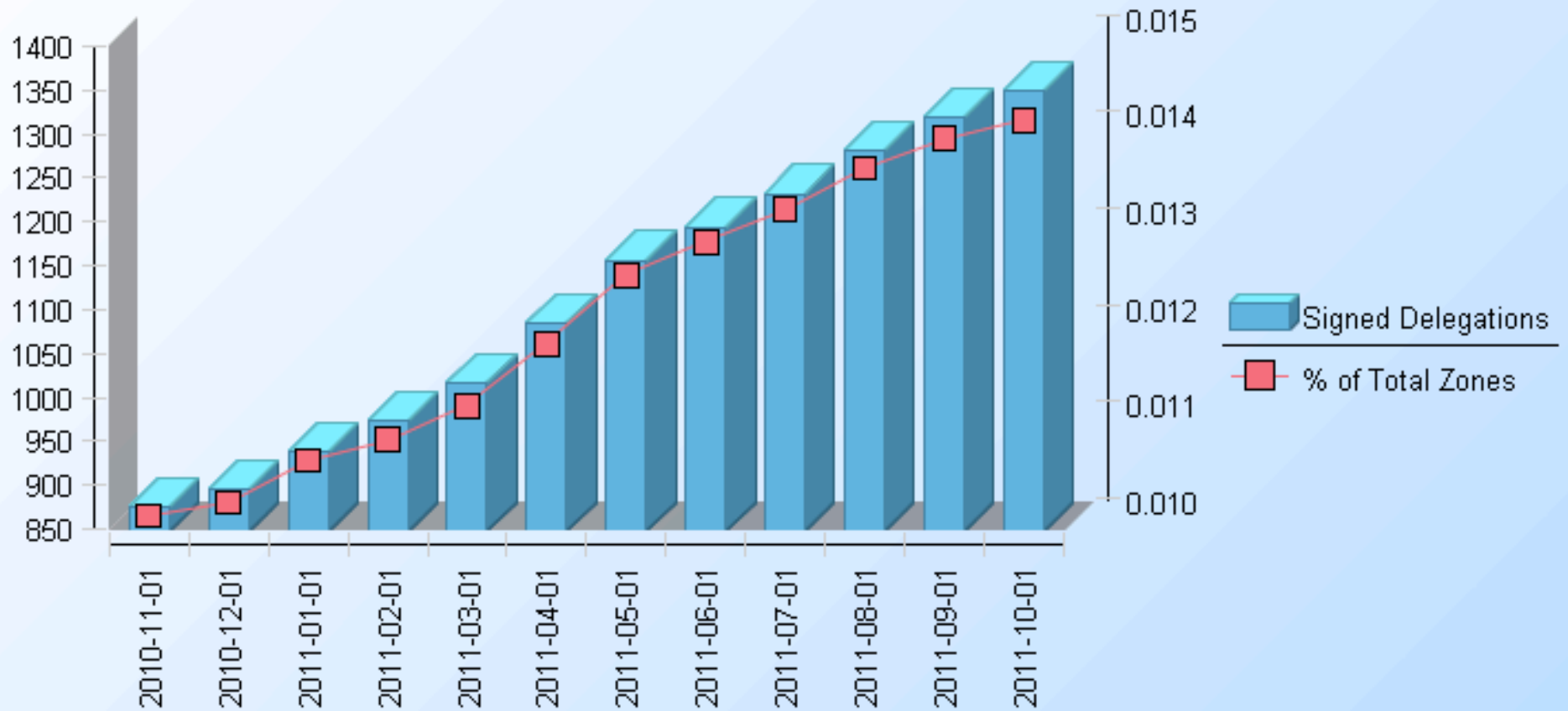
IPv4 and IPv6 DS Queries % of Total by TLD for 2011-10-07

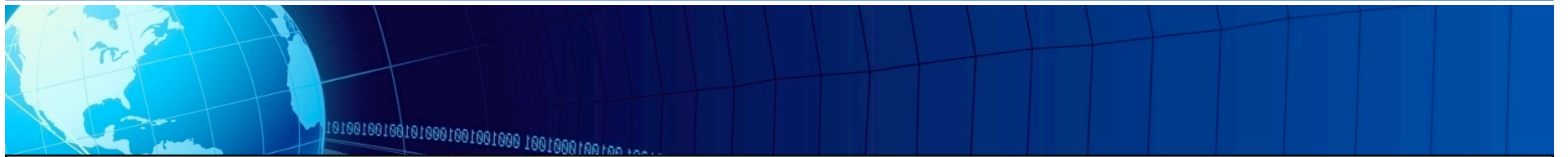


IPv4 and IPv6 KEY Queries % of Total by TLD for 2011-10-07

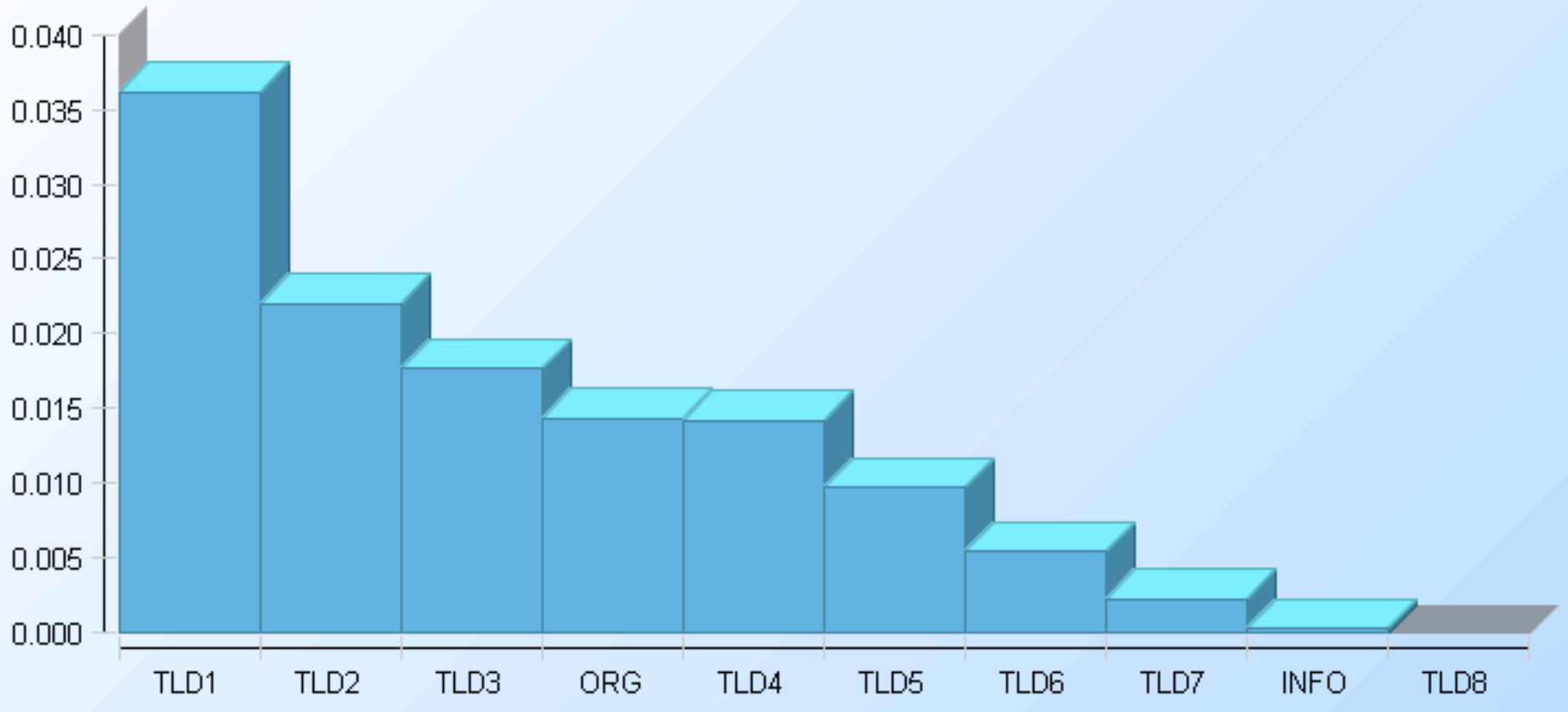


Signed Delegations and % of Total for ORG for Last 12 Months
