- SSR-RT2 Formed in Fall 2010
- Cartagena:
  - First face-to-face
- San Francisco:
  - Formation of 3 sub-teams, based on review-team mandate
- Singapore:
  - Evaluation of work achieved
  - Closer focus on tasks
  - Restructured for streamlining, results-oriented
  - Core Research and Drafting Team
- Washington
  - Detailed analysis breakdown
  - Assignment of 'work packets' – WBS (work breakdown structure)

  - Governance
  - Scope and scope-creeep
  - Clarity of remit
