Aim of Survey:

To Assess Readiness and Plans of African
ccTLDs to adopt DNSSEC



Natures of Survey

- Ask ccTLDs to indicate their level of adoption of DNSSEC
- Survey done in collaboration with SSAC
- Used online survey tools
- Survey sent out to all AfTLD mailing lists
- Results collated



Survey Questionnaire

1. Date Internal experimentation began
2. Date you announced DNSSEC would definitely be deployed (Not the date when it will be deployed; the date you made the announcement)
3. Date of Partial Operation
4. Date the zone was fully Operational



Outcome of Survey

| Question | Number of Respondents | Summary of Responses |
|--|-----------------------|---|
| Date Internal experimentation began | 7 | All had no plans, .tz, .ke plan to start experimentation soon |
| Date you announced DNSSEC would definitely be deployed | 7 | No definite plans by most respondents. .tz had date |
| Date of Partial Operation | 7 | No definite dates by all respondents |
| Date the zone was fully Operational | 7 | No definite date by all respondents |



Challenges

- Method of conducting survey not very targeted
- Questionnaire did not seek to tease awareness of need for DNS security by ccTLDs in Africa
- Many registries in Africa small and priority is making registries run properly



Way Forward

- Many ccTLDs not sensitized enough on DNSSEC
- Re-do survey with greater focus on level of appreciation of need for DNSSEC and deployment
- Plan capacity building activity with SSAC on Deployment of DNSSEC
