

.ORG DNSSEC Activity

June 2009



.ORG is Signed with DNSSEC

- » .ORG is the first open generic Top-Level Domain to successfully sign the zone
- » Zone signing occurred on June 2, 2009
 - This occurred without incident
 - No end user complaints to date





.ORG is signed – What now?

- » Kicking off our Friends & Family Test Period
 - Domain Names
 - Manually inserted DS records in 3 test domains
 - Check them out!
 - » www.sanxion.org
 - » www.automagic.org
 - » www.bondis.org
 - Plans to include a number of other test domains to the testing plan in the next few weeks.

 - Full Production Readiness
 - Planned 2010 launch of DNSSEC for all registrars and registrants wanting to sign their zones

» ITAR

- The .ORG key was submitted to the ITAR on 6/19/09


» DLV

 Expectation that .ORG will be imported into ISC's DLV in approximately a week after it's appearance in the ITAR.

- » Held a DNSSEC panel the 2009 RSA conference
- » Launched DNSSEC Resources on the PIR Website (http://pir.org/dnssecinfo)
- » Continued blog updates on DNSSEC information and news
- » The DNSSEC Coalition continues to grow and work towards increasing the awareness & adoption of DNSSEC.
