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Malicious Behaviours

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Overarching principle

- "Constant vigilance"
- (Mad Eye Moody, Defence Against the Dark Arts Professor, Harry Potter)

Phishing and fraud

- Registrar is the principal point of contact
- Phishing lock for immediate removal of domain from zone file and lock to prevent use/ re-registration
- Nominet intervenes at request of law enforcement (very rare)

Non Rights Complaints

- Thick Registry with a direct contract with each registrant in addition to the registrar
- Nominet investigates registrant breaches
 - Inadequate/ false registrant information
 - Dissolved company registrants
 - WHOIS opt out
- Notify admin contacts and put on notice
- Suspend 30 days
- Cancel registration
- Registrar complaints

New gTLD operator issues

- How to deal with criminal use of domains
 - Preparation for malice and fraud
 - Denial of service attacks = technical rigour and systems
- Good relationships with registrars and law enforcement
 - Registry has a co-ordination function
- Registry reputation will be key to long term success
 - Prevention better than cure
