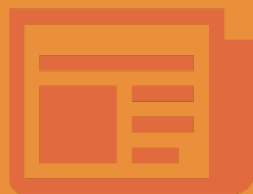
New gTLD Subsequent Procedures

Overview

Community efforts, such as a PDP and various reviews, are underway to take into consideration the 2012 New gTLD round and seek ways to improve, refine, or develop new policy recommendations for new gTLDs, acknowledging that there is existing new gTLD policy from the GNSO's 2007 Final Report on the Introduction of New gTLDs.

What to Expect at ICANN57

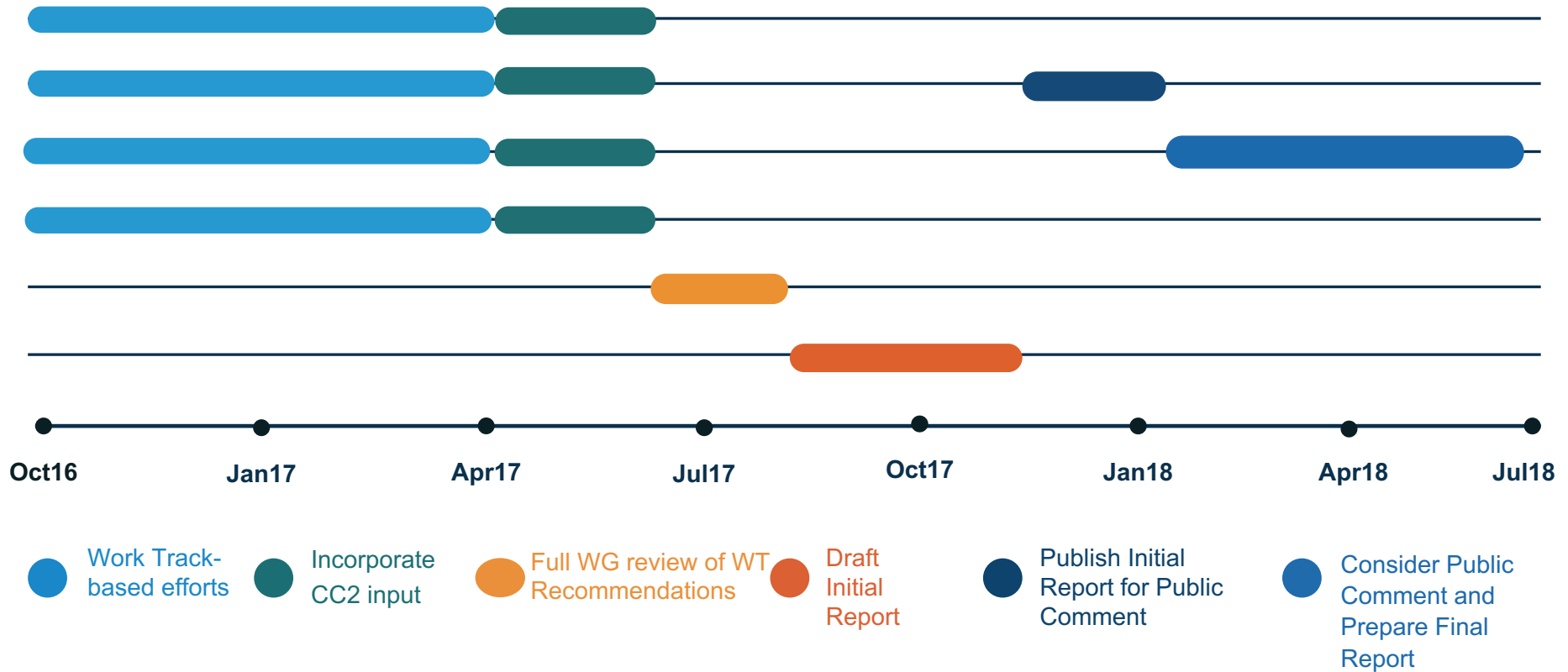

Current Status

- Topics currently under review by WT1
 - Registry Service Provider (RSP) Accreditation/Certification
 - Determining what might be the most effective program for RSPs, Registry Operators, registrars, applicants, etc.
 - What practices are needed to maintain or improve security and stability?
 - Applicant Support Program
 - Reviewing policy and implementation of Applicant Support Program from 2012 round
 - Examining why there was limited utilization of the program
 - Applicant Guidebook
 - Is the AGB the correct implementation mechanism for new gTLD policy recommendations?
