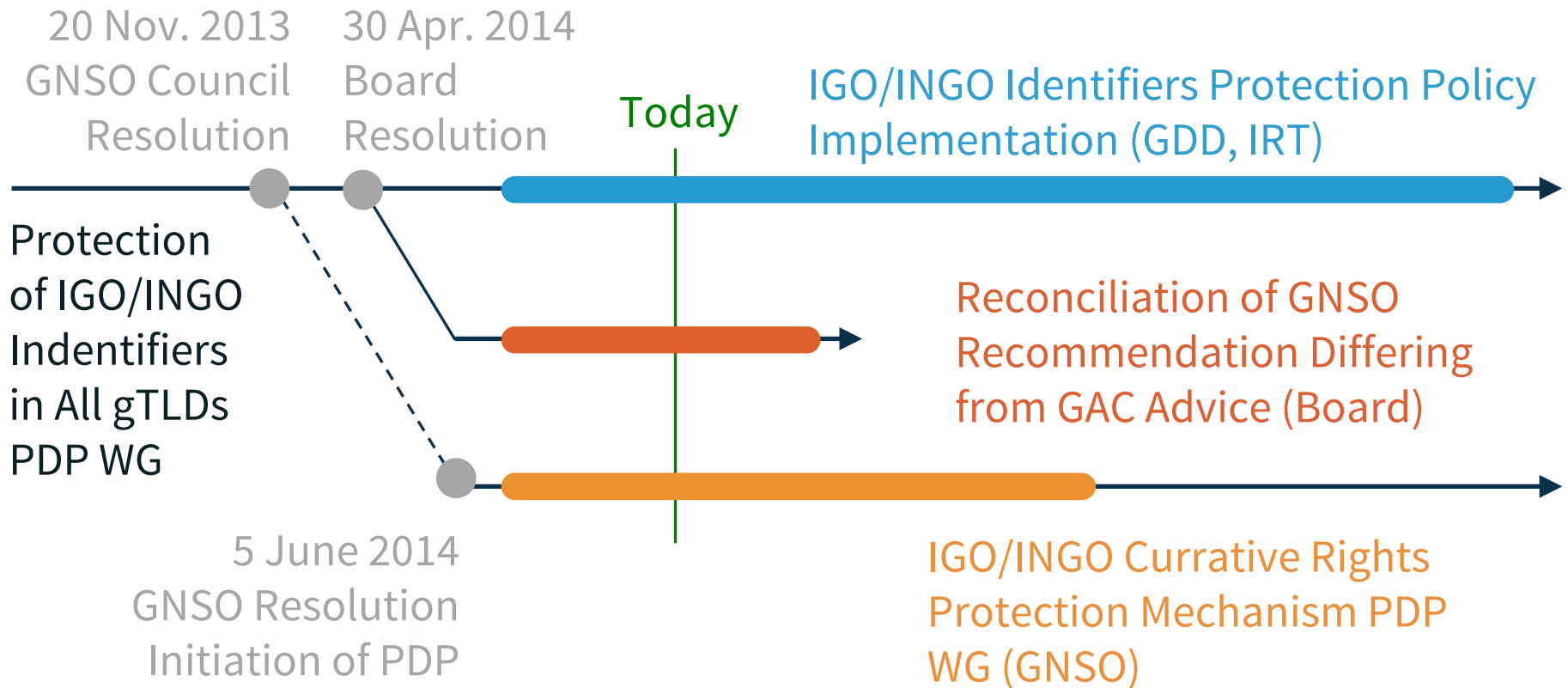
Project Background

This Policy Development Process (PDP) was initiated to develop policy recommendations for the provision of protection for identifiers of certain International Governmental Organizations (IGOs) and International Non-Governmental Organizations (INGOs), including the Red Cross/Red Crescent Movement (RCRC) and the International Olympic Committee (IOC).

The PDP Working Group completed its work in November 2013 and its consensus recommendations were approved by the GNSO Council. In April 2014, the ICANN Board adopted those of the PDP recommendations that were “not inconsistent” with GAC advice received on the topic, and requested more time to consider the remaining, inconsistent recommendations.

The adopted recommendations relate to protection at the top- and second-level for specific RCRC, IOC and IGO names (with an Exception Procedure to be designed for the affected organizations), and a 90-day Claims Notification process at the second-level for certain INGO acronyms.

Implementation Plan and Status

- ⦿ Draft policy language document
 - Draft version 6.1 provided to IRT for review
 - Team plan to review at ICANN57 session

- ⦿ Secure initial lists of identifiers and required data
 - RCRC, IOC, INGO identifiers – complete
 - INGOs contact data – complete
 - IGOs identifiers – incomplete
 - Seeking “up to two languages” from GAC

- ⦿ Develop systems and processes
 - Full name reservation process
 - Use current system/process
 - 90-day claims system
 - Initial proposal received from current TMCH service provider
 - Implementation team to review and prepare for contract

 1. INGO: Claims system/process
 2. IGO, IOC, RCRC list update process
 3. Draft policy document
- ⦿ Publish final policy and announce policy effective date
 1. IGO list: up to two languages from GAC
 2. IOC list
 3. RCRC list
 4. INGO list: ECOSOC list with contact info
 5. Claims system designed and ready to implement
 6. Implementation notes for Registries
 7. Final consensus policy language
- ⦿ Policy effective date
 1. Policy language posted
 2. Claims system operational

Draft Policy Document – IRT Review

- ⦿ IGO/INGO Identifier Protection Policy
 - Draft version 6.4
 - Distributed to IRT on 27 October 2017

- ⦿ Key features:
 - Scope clarification at the beginning
 - Two main sections
 - Section 1: Red Cross, IOC, IGO
 - Section 2: INGO
 - No identifier list in the document
 - Refers to the “lists”
 - This is to avoid policy revision when names and/or languages are added or deleted in the future

Next Steps for Implementation Team

- ⦿ Review INGO claims system proposal and document procedure
- ⦿ Define list update processes
- ⦿ Finalize draft policy document for public comment

- ⦿ Next IRT meetings:
 - Monthly calls to be scheduled
