



- Predictable patterns of Interaction





Exogenous Variables

Biophysical Conditions

One of the four type of goods

Attributes of the Community

History of prior interactions, Internal homogeneity /heterogeneity of key attributes, community knowledge and social capital

Rules-in-use

Common understanding of those involved. These evolve over time as stakeholders interact



Variables in an Action Situation

- Participants
- Position
- Outcomes
- Action-Outcome Linkages
- The Control that participants exercise
- Information
- The cost and benefits assigned to Outcomes

Variables for an Actor

- The resources that an actor brings to a situation
- The valuation actors assign to state of the world and to actions
- Processing Knowledge and Information
- The processes actors use for selection of particular courses of action

Need for the Study?

Because ICANN is Special

- Understand how complex governance structures govern a common-pool resource
- Provides an assessment of past efforts
- Explains behavior within a governance setup
- Can aid in future reforms and transitions
