Internet Engineering Task Force (IETF)

- Internet Engineering Task Force creates the standards used for the Internet
 - Request for Comments (RFCs)
- IETF activity organized into "Working Groups" (WGs)
- WGs established with a "charter" of the standards they are expected to create
- WGs "closed" when the standards are completed and published
- "Birds of a Feather" sessions (BOFs) occasionally take place to bring new work into the IETF
- Anyone can participate in a WG via the email list
- Anyone can submit an "Internet Draft"






Primary Task Of Working Groups

IETF Meetings

- IETF working groups do their primary work by email
- Three times a year the IETF gathers in different parts of the world to meet face-to-face for one week

DNS Operations (DNSOP)

- Focused on operations and deployment aspects of DNS
- Primary place where DNSSEC-related activity occurs

- Aggressive NSEC Caching https://tools.ietf.org/html/draft-ietf-dnsop-nsec-aggressiveuse-08

DANE

- Created DANE protocol for TLS
- In the process of finishing up its work

• DNS Privacy (DPRIVE)

- Focused on DNS privacy ex. DNS over TLS
