### 1. Next Generation RDS PDP WG

Main Issues of Concern for the GAC and PSWG

- ⊙ Data Protection and Privacy
  - Possibility of conflicts between RDS Policy and national or supranational law such as Data Protection Rules
  - The GAC 2007 Principles on gTLD WHOIS services call for a balance between privacy and law enforcement/public interest in attribution of responsibility for online content or services
- Gated Access to registration information and jurisdictional issues
  - Implementation of a Gated or Tiered access RDS may create jurisdictional issues for law enforcement when requesting data from private entities across borders
  - Adopting an accreditation scheme that would entitle law enforcement authorities to access gated (or protected) data on a global scale may be difficult to achieve

# 2. Child Protection

#### $\odot~$ Background and Outcome of ICANN 57 $\,$

- John Carr circulated a paper prior to ICANN 57
- Feedback from PSWG Working Session in Hyderabad (Transcript)
  - Interest in shortfalls of Spec 11 and work of CCT Review (AU)
  - Interest in costs associated with Nominet's implementation, and extent of TLDs to be considered (UK)
  - Consider developing detailed provisions to apply to registries (US FBI)
  - Concerns with risk of engaging ICANN in content regulation as well as sensitivities around how different countries deal with child online protection (US)
- Status:
  - Experience with **дети** (xn--d1acj3b) Russian for "kids/deti"
  - .KIDS String Contention not yet resolved
  - Ongoing development of proposes Terms of services for Registries



# 2. Child Protection

#### Next Steps

- ⊙ Short Term
  - Seek Support from relevant International Organisation
  - Advocate Voluntary adoption of Terms of Service
    - Among ccTLDs
    - Among gTLDs, in particular
      - Sensitive Strings
      - .KIDS Applicants in Contention Set (potential Auction)
- ⊙ Longer Term
  - Seek changes in Applicant Guidebook (New gTLD Subsequent Procedures PDP)
  - Seek use of Auction Proceeds to fund appropriate mechanism to verify sensitive string



### 3. New gTLD Subsequent Procedures PDP

#### $\odot$ Background

- GNSO PDP initiated on December 2015 <u>https://gnso.icann.org/en/group-activities/active/new-gtld-subsequent-procedures</u>
- PDP Working Group tasked with determining what changes (if any) may need to be made to the existing policy recommendation on the Introduction of New gTLDs

#### $\odot~$ Several issues of potential interest to the PSWG

- Registry Service Providers Accreditation
- Single vs. categorized Registry Agreement
- Continued Operations and Emergency Back-End Registry Operators
- Due diligence on technical competence and financial capability (at application time or upon signing of Registry Agreement with ICANN?)
- Improvement of evaluation criteria and process
- Name Collisions and Identification of High Risk strings
- PDP WG Working on <u>Community Consultation Questions</u>
  - PSWG may assist the GAC in preparing answers to relevant questions
