



Next-Gen gTLD RDS Policy Requirements What to expect at ICANN59?

Overview

This PDP has been tasked with defining the purpose of collecting, maintaining and providing access to gTLD registration data and considering safeguards for protecting that data. This WG is expected to establish consensus requirements for gTLD registration data and directory services, using them to determine if and why a next-generation RDS is needed and then establish a policy framework to support those requirements.

What to Expect at ICANN59

This is an open working session of the RDS PDP WG. In this session, the WG will

- Plan to address Cross-Community Discussion feedback, and
- Start deliberating on Access requirements for gTLD Registrant Data.

RDS PDP: Project Timeline & Major Milestones



DURING PHASE 1, THIS WG MUST ADDRESS THESE QUESTIONS:

- What are the <u>fundamental requirements</u> for gTLD registration data? When addressing this, the PDP WG should consider, at a minimum, users & purposes, access, accuracy, data elements, and privacy (charter questions 1-5)
- Is a new policy framework and a next-generation system needed to address these requirements?
 - If yes, what <u>cross-cutting requirements</u> must any next-generation RDS address, including coexistence, compliance, system model, cost/benefit & risk analysis (charter questions 6-11)
 - If no, does the current WHOIS policy framework sufficiently address these requirements? If not, what revisions are recommended to the current WHOIS policy framework to do so?

- Finish deliberating on charter questions 1-5
- Answer Foundational Question
- First Initial Report
- Modify Phase 1 Work Plan
- Deliberate on charter questions 6-11
- Second Initial Report
- Final Report for Phase 1

If a next-gen RDS is needed:

- Phase 2 (Policy Development)
- Phase 3 (Implementation and Coexistence Guidance)
