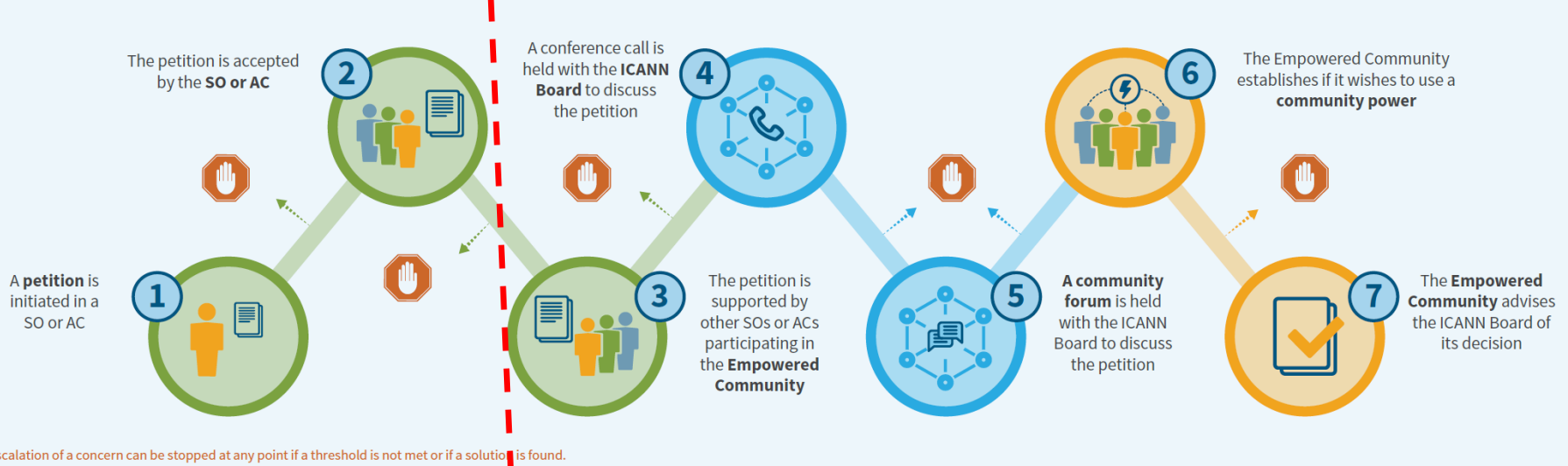

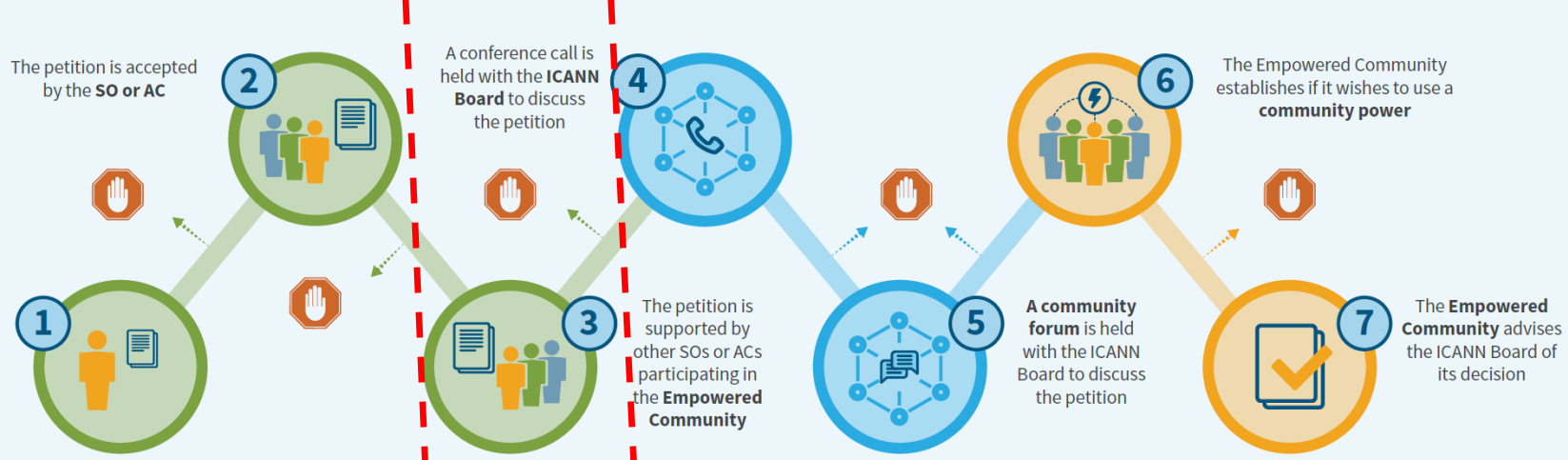

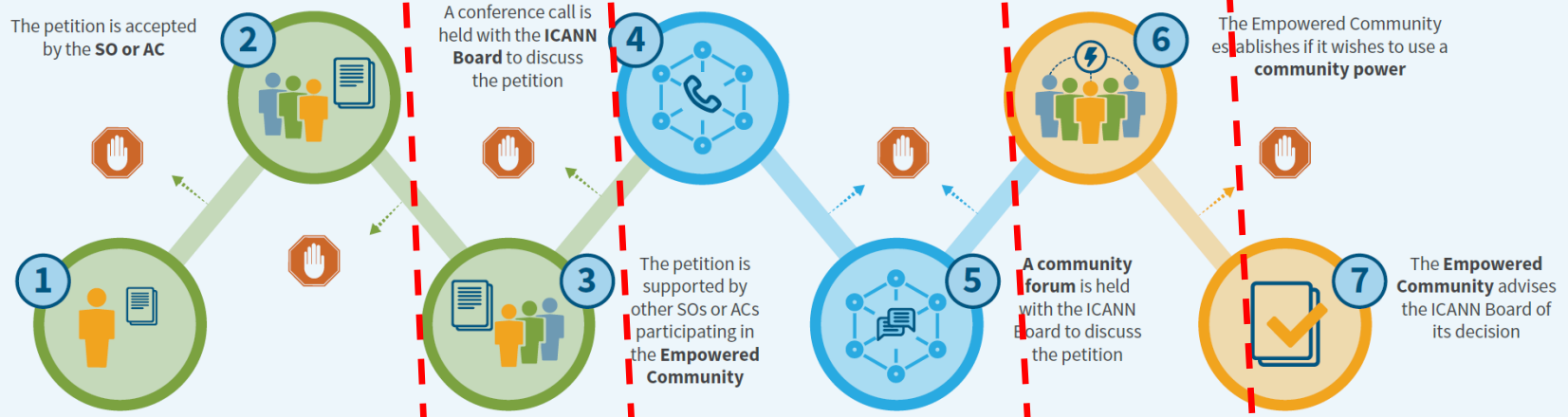

Full ccNSO Process according to the Rules of the ccNSO (2004)



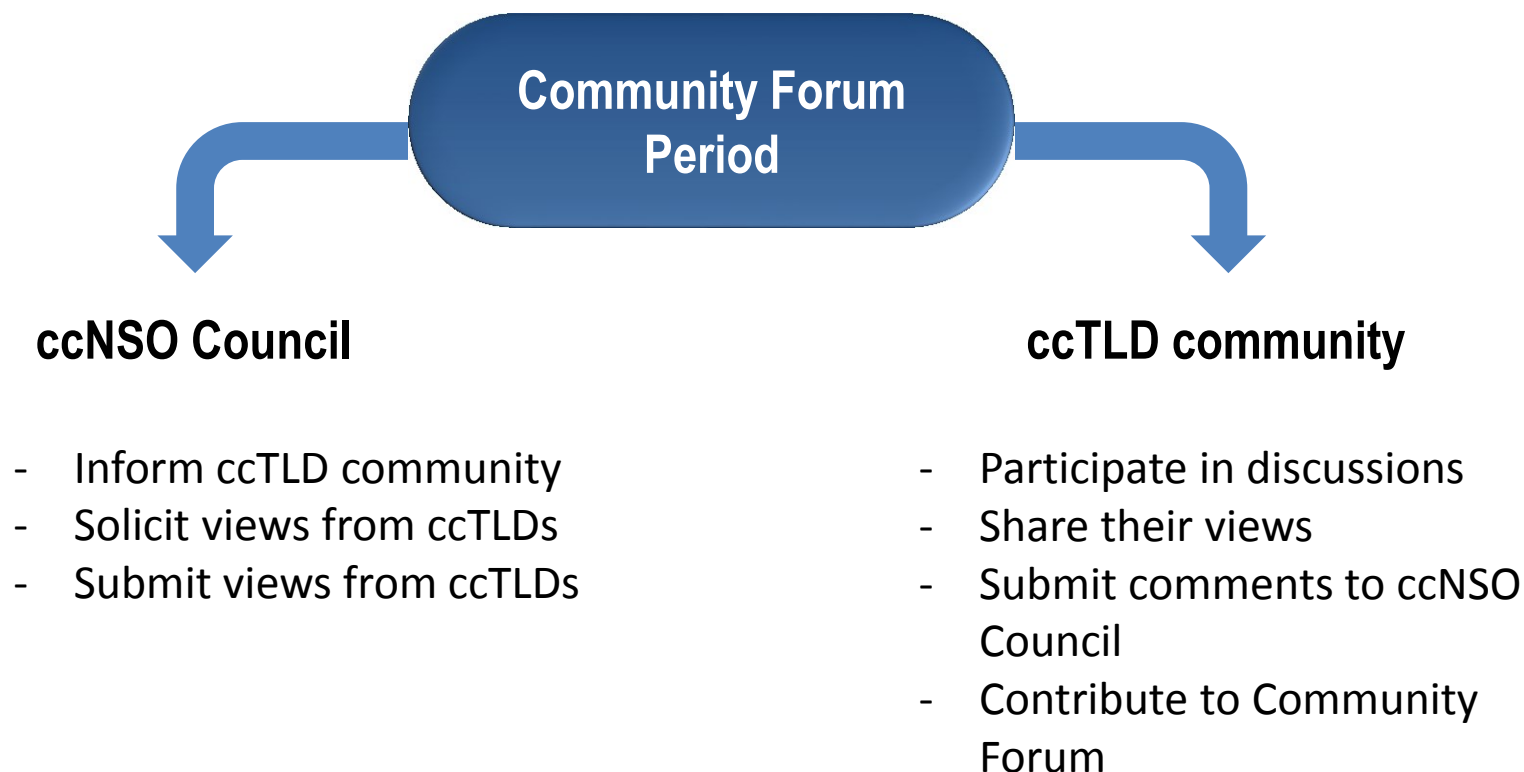

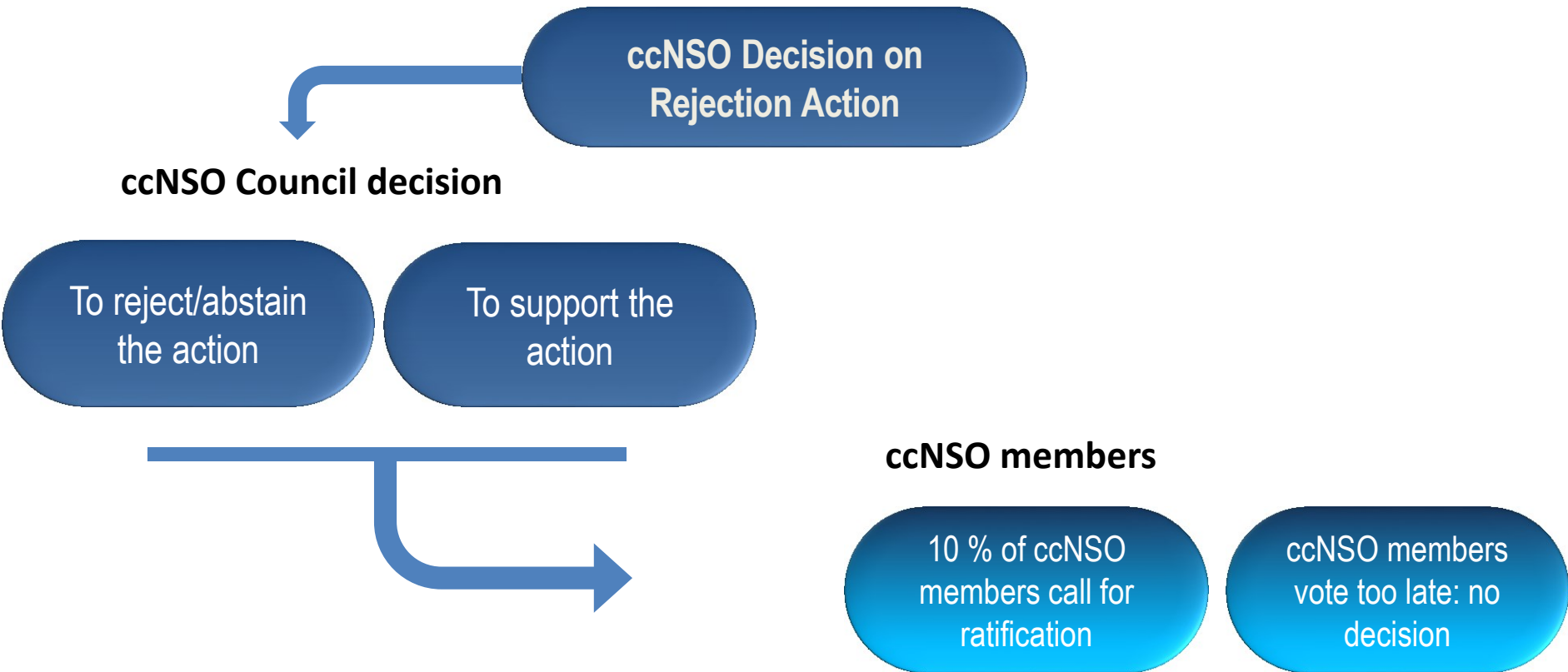
