Managing NS and glue records requires Registrant action



- Requires Human action from Registrant / Technical Contact
 - Usually involves a non-standard web portal at Registrar
- DNS Operators often not registered as Technical Contact


Automatic updating of NS and glue records

- Requires child zone in DNSSEC signed has a DS record at parent. This authenticates the update process
- Child publishes a CSYNC record specifying SOA, flags, RRtypes

redhat.com. IN CSYNC 2017062401 3 NS A AAAA
```

- Child can remove CSYNC record when it notices parent has updated

DNS Operator triggered update



- Out of band agreement on hidden primary NS possible
- Out of band child to parent trigger possible
