## ICANN

- According to the UNFPA, 66% of the SA population are below 35 years of age.
- 54 million South Africans, where:
- 18.5% are between ages of 10 − 19. and
- 24% between 15-24.



UN wrote in Africa Renewed (online):

- Population between ages of 15-24 estimated at 200 million people.
- The UNPD and Africa development bank among others, indicated that the figure would DOUBLE by 2045.

Are we sufficiently monopolizing on this as change agents in Africa?
