During a session yesterday someone said that all "comments" needed to be in English. That **NEEDS TO CHANGE.**

How about instead of typing `<comment>` or `<suggestion>` we actually use some **EMOJI.**

It is hard to bring in new people, but we can also build **MORE SOCIAL INTERACTION** into virtual meetings.

Shorter presentations by panels and **MORE TIME FOR INTERACTION**

Integration of **MORE POLLING** for interaction

Think about future ICANN Public Meetings from a **SUBSTANCE PERSPECTIVE**, not just the logistics. What are the 'issues' or 'policy' that the community needs to progress?

We could make many **SESSIONS SHORTER** by reducing the endless reiteration of process or background.
