

At a Glance


- Purpose of the Transfer Policy: provide a straightforward procedure for registrants to securely transfer their domain names from one registrar to another.
- Previous policy work recommended the Transfer Policy be reviewed following the implementation of all recommendations.
- Represented WG began meeting in May 2021.
- WG currently working through Phase 1A charter questions, which includes questions on the Auth-info code, Losing FOA, Gaining FOA, and Denial of Transfers. (Note: Phase 1A expanded to include Denial of Transfers following PCR.)



- WG Completed review of public comments and confirmed revised Recommendation text for #1, #2 and #5.
- Five proposed recommendations for Final Report (April 2022):
 - Add definition of "IGO Complainant"
 - 2. IGOs exempt from agreement to submit to Mutual Jurisdiction
 - 3. Arbitration option following a UDRP decision
 - 4. Arbitration option following a URS decision
 - 5. Determining the applicable law for arbitration

- ICANN73 Session Cancelled due to conflicts with community group meetings







Focus of the EPDP is on:


- the definition of all gTLDs and the management of variant labels to facilitate the delegation of variant gTLDs in the root zone while achieving the security and usability goal of variant labels in a stable manner; and
- how the IDN Implementation Guidelines, which Contracted Parties are required to comply with, should be updated in the future.

The EPDP takes into account existing work, including the IDNs related recommendations from SubPro

- Scoping Team held its first meeting on 5 October 2021.
- Scoping Team has four assignments:
 - Enforcement & Reporting (definition)
 - Accuracy Measurement (gap analysis)
 - Effectiveness
 - Impact and Improvement
- Scoping Team work has been greatly facilitated by contributions from ICANN Org, including Compliance.
- Scoping Team is currently focusing on working on a gap analysis to identify the delta between current accuracy requirements and enforcement and perceived issues as well as how these perceived issues can be confirmed.
