According to various estimates, about **45 million** people in the world speak Ukrainian, and it is one of the second ten most widely spoken languages in the world



Multistakeholderism – key principle of Internet governance, requiring joint management of Internet resources by governments, business and the civil society in their respective roles



- functions as a linguistic borrowing
- has no authentic equivalent which leads to conglomeration and confusion
- requires standardization

Internet governance (IG) – the rules, norms, mechanisms, and organizations through which the global Internet community’s many stakeholders work together to shape the evolution and use of the Internet



- there are more than 5 ways of translating this term
- deciding on one way of interpreting the term and adding it to the official glossary will make it simpler to complete further translation

Ransomware attack – a form of malware in which the attacker disables or disrupts a victim's computer and demands payment to undo the damage



- mislabeled as a virus or named virus-extortioner
- cannot be used as borrowing in the interpreted text because it will not convey its full meaning

Public interest – refers to parts of the Internet that can be considered as a global public good essential for the welfare or well-being of the general public



- initially, this term has to show how beneficial and crucial for society is something
- most interpreters use a literal translation approach here, but it does not sound accurate enough

Multiculturalism is **the key** to fruitful work of the **ICANN community**:

- raise the awareness of the secure Internet
- engage people with different cultural and academic backgrounds in ensuring a stable and fast Internet since those whose first language is not English are currently excluded from experiencing the full benefits of the Internet
