The Role of ALSes

APRALO RULES OF PROCEDURE

11 Performance, Metrics and Remediation

11.1 The ability of the APRALO to represent the interest of Internet users depends on strong participation from all APRALO Members and Appointees.

Furthermore, the APRALO can function effectively only if all APRALO Members and Appointees meet the obligations of their positions.

Satisfactory performance is a complex concept including both objective and subjective issues, and must factor in the very significant personal contributions made by At-Large volunteers.

Moreover, the APRALO and At-Large receive significant funding from ICANN, both for travel and other activities, and the APRALO must be able to justify such expense.
