The Process: the ICG

IANA Stewardship Transition Coordination Group ICG:

- -30 individuals, direct and indirect stakeholders
- -ccTLD representatives are:
 - Xiaodong Lee .cn
 - Mary Uduma .ng
 - Keith Davidson .nz
 - Martin Boyle .uk
 - Mohamed El Bashir .qa (ALAC) & Demi Getschko (ISOC), Hartmut Glaser (ASO) .br
- -Coordinate the development of a proposal among the communities affected by the IANA functions
- -In parallel with the ICANN accountability process
- Issued a Request for Proposals from protocols, numbers and naming communities

- IANA functions currently specified in NTIA contract. IANA administration of registries containing:
 - DNS root zone
 - Internet numbering resources
 - Protocol parameters
- Stewardship (not policy development, etc.)

Request for Proposals

Requests complete formal proposals from processes convened by operational communities

- All interested parties should get involved in the relevant community process
- Interested parties can submit comments directly to ICG about specific aspects of proposals, the community processes or ICG's processes
- ICG will address comments to the relevant operational community wherever appropriate

Community proposal processes should be open & inclusive

Communities asked to actively seek out and encourage wider participation by other parties interested in the response

Proposal Elements - I

Description of Community's Use of IANA Functions

- Description of function
- Description of the customer(s) of the function
- What registries are involved in providing the function
- A description of any overlaps or interdependencies between your IANA requirements and the functions required by other customer communities

Proposal Elements - II

Existing, Pre-Transition Arrangements

- Policy Sources
 - Description of how policy is developed & established.
 Who is involved?
 - How are disputes about policy resolved?
 - References to documentation
- Oversight & Accountability
 - Description of oversight or accountability
 - Description of the mechanism, including the consequences of the IANA operator not meeting standards, transparency...
 - Jurisdiction(s) and the legal basis for the mechanism

Proposal Elements - III

Proposed Oversight & Accountability Arrangements

- Changes to oversight & accountability arrangements in light of the transition. Proposals to replace existing arrangements should be explained and the elements of oversight & accountability should be described for the new arrangements with the rationale and justification for the new arrangements
- Implications for the interface between the IANA functions and existing policy arrangements
- If the community is not proposing changes to oversight & accountability, the rationale and justification should be provided

The Process: the CWG

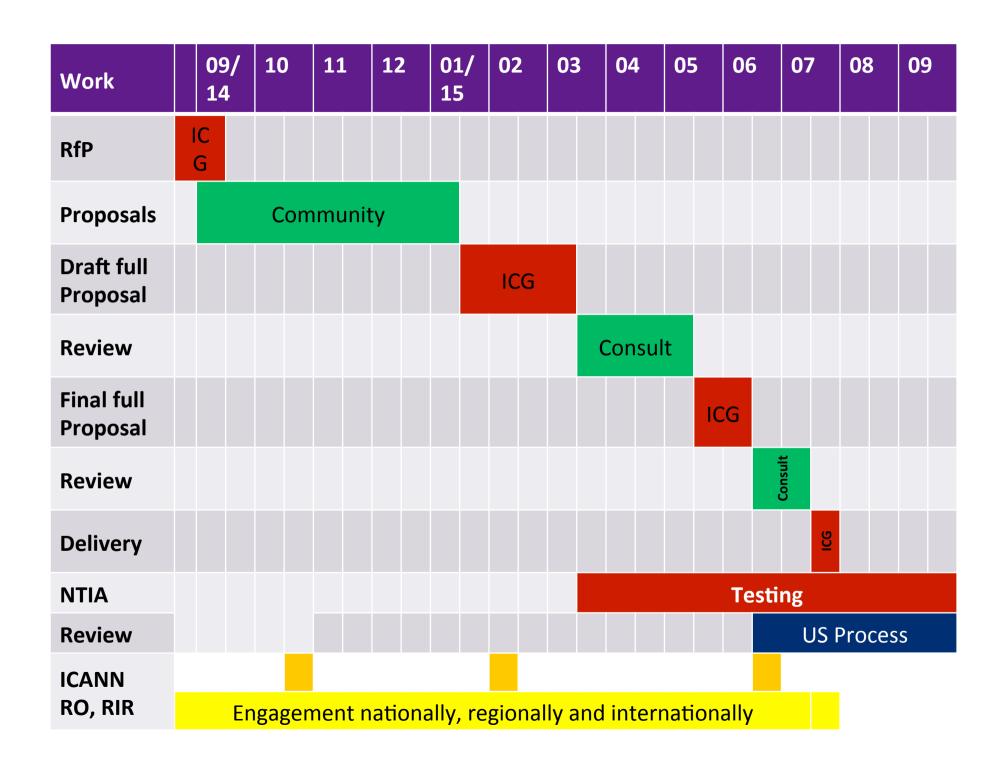
Cross-community Working Group to Develop an IANA Stewardship Transition Proposal on Naming Related Functions (CWG on Stewardship Transition)

- -Produce consolidated transition proposal for the elements of the IANA Functions relating to the Domain Name System
- Principles of openness, diversity, global participation, involvement of affected parties, transparency, and bottom-up, consensus-based decision-making
- -Expectation that will operate as much as possible with the views and consensus support of all participants
- -GNSO, ccNSO, SSAC, ALAC, GAC adopted the charter
- -ccTLD members from .dk, .pe, .ac, .za, .se
- -Open to observers who can contribute to the discussion
